#### **Report from Timisoara Life Center Ministry**

Our Life students ended greatly the year of 2021-2022, finishing excellently, especially those who studied onto the medical school universities.



Now, spiritually speaking, our Life students are well taught and educated as this is a most important part of their life, the learning to develop a walking relationship with the Lord, knowing Him and making Him known to others. The practical side of this Life ministry is activated to reach the world within the love of Jesus, either on personal basis or in the group format outreaches.

They are scheduled on trip outreaches back to their villages, the families they came from as many of their own tribal kin are not knowing the Lord. And they GO to sing the love of the Lord who died and now lives for them; teaching them to pray together while reaching to their needs, heralding the message of salvation, and eternal living miracles often intersects within this empowered ministry as it was ordered by our Lord.

We are also preparing to recruit a new breed of Life students, choosing the called ones who are truly needing our help.We want these who are willing to learn the new principles of a true life, the disciple's disciplines, morally and professionally. They'll then be ready to make a difference in their communities. As you know, the Lord's call and anointing becomes perfected when they are

practically and actively involved into the real Life outreach ministries, sharing their stories and evangelizing; working in prison and orphan ministries, helping the elders, as well the busy moms with lots of kids; and providing meals to the poor families, etc.

**Since the Ukrainian war Life Center received 8 refugees among them**. They received the same Life treatment as our own family of students have. Consequently, the Life Center is more than a life training student body but is known around the city as a missionary outreach center. Here the emergency life needs are served well as we activated both sides, the ministry team and the provision of God's blessings.

I especially want to acknowledge here the Life Outreach International of Fort Worth, TX, James and Betty Robison. As well to other friends who here and there are participating to stand along with us.

I do encourage also the USA ministries and church teams to come and help us while being housed with us at the Life Center, ministering along the student body; to bless the Center with their financial support as this is aiding on furthering this worthwhile ministry to reach Romania for Christ.

**The Olive Branch Church of Radauti continued to reach the Ukrainian towns** and villages with the Gospel of Jesus Christ – While heralding the Gospel of the Kingdom, teaching how to follow Christ by trusting His Word the church dealt with their shortages and needs as feeding and food provisions, clotting or their infirmities.

Pastor Dorel and his dedicated team took mission trips in Ukraine, lately in towns like Krivomy Rozy, Dnepr, Krivoi Rog, as well Privorochea. Around this area were distributed over twenty tones of basic foods and other housing supplies fulfilling urgent needs of 240 families who were depleted of basic survival foods as many lost their jobs as their sources of income vanished.

**Pastor Ilie Popa of Suceava outreach is continuing to reach the Ukrainian refugees** still living in Suceava, Botosani and Iasi area.

Pastor Ilie and his disciple's team, actively opens up house churches in the counties of Suceava and Piatra Neamt, these churches are rapidly growing to a couple of dozen. Jesus said, that His Church starts from two or three united together as one when He is present amongst them. In our days so easily we forgot His Church Life principle. During all this I didn't ever hear Pastor Ilie speaking about the need of a building or expansions since it's so easy to open another sister home church to encamp the new believers. As a good consequence, the building funds goes up for the foreigners, the refugees, and for the needs around them. Now, the funds that we had sent to this ministerial church most of it went to the charitable needs and projects, though about half of this amount was designated for the personal church outreaches, and ministerial personal needs.

However, more than half went for the Ukrainian refugees needs, \$2500 were donated to Kairos Ukrainian outreach where the apostolic church members also serve as volunteers. Next, the family of Achim and Elvira Ignat was blessed with \$1500. The family was a church planter missionary in the Transylvanian region of Salaj, who planted several churches. But a few years ago brother Achim became fully disabled and bed ridden lacking any retirement income. So, this sum made this saintly old family to continue living by faith and by the obedience of His own people both there and also American people who stood behind them too. What a Grace from God we have! Also a few urgent needs of other families were met as well, so at the end the church didn't use anything for them as initially designated other than for travel and gas expenses.

Now, I do ask you, if this Suceava church was needing expanding facilities or new buildings, these replies where these funds would have gone, but instead people are blessed all over around them. Let's just move on, Kingdom is here!

Now ending with a prayer request for a charitable project, the Christian clinic of Poaina Mare, Dolj, led by the doctor Denisa Feca, and her missionary husband in the area. They have about \$10,000 debt to pay for the Romania finances. Like in the USA – IRS, here the State tax collectors made a mistake in their yearly accounting, then they later billed them with this extra money, so they needed to pay back to the government. However, I asked Claudiu to go and make a deal to lower this amount, I'm not sure if he may succeed but best to try it the best, as this is Romania not America where stuff like it is possible. Even though the poor people pay just an honorary fee for their medical services, but this government doesn't recognize it as a charitable ministry.

We need to pray for God's favor, but also for the provision to pay off what is due to them. This is just to pray for Denisa and Claudiu Feca, so their problem may be solved, either way. But the Clinic stays open for the poverty people around them. And if there is the Voice to give, obey and give it.

*The church in Radauti, got an emergency for a sister who dedicated to the Lord sister* named Angelica Haj. She was left as a single mom to raise and provide alone for her four school aged children. When her husband and the father of these children went for a better job in Italy he was drawn to live with other foreign women, at last falling in love with a young lady who wanted him to divorce completely his own family and he did.

In the meantime, Angelica had found the Lord and dedicated her life to Christ and her four her fatherless children are serving the Lord. They all got involved in the church worship team as they have great voices and musically talented.



However, she was unable to pay for her rented apartment and utility expenses as her hospital part time job hardly provides the food, clothing and the children's schooling. Here pastor Dorel of the Olive branch church intervened to rescue this family out from the State hands as the Child Protection was eyeing to take her children away from their mom. However, this rather small but dedicated church got involved to stand as a guarantor for her home paying expenses. But not easy for them too, as the highest expense is the apartment rent besides its utility expenses. Then the church was led to build them a little home when a lot was donated by a church member to rescue the family. The home building project started but the church incoming possibilities are not enough to finish up the home. Actually, the lacking void is above the \$10.000 that may be needed to finish this home project, as they believe before the cold harsh winter to move the family into their new home.

If God speaks to one or more of us to get aligned in this project that is truly a charitable rescuing act, this mightily will bless this wonderful mom and her own kids who were left to cry with desperation after their father's abandonment

*Recently, Pastor Relu told me the story of southern Romania powerful evangelism* followed by water baptisms. While starting the new believers discipling schools, and Bible seminars, may the new prospecting leaders become the next generation of pastors, shepherding the multiplication of new planted churches. Here reaching the Word from town to town the evangelistic team reached Bechet town right on the border of Bulgaria.

There a man who just was out of a long term prison time for killing his wife (as he felt she was unfaithful to him). But then he was convicted and understood that he was possessed by a lying spirit of jealousy, but it was late when he realized that she was innocently and falsely accused. Right after the baptism of others he had fallen on his knees and face down protesting before the pastor and his team crying loudly to God for forgiveness, as then he lived under Satan's influence.



But here Jesus delivered him and now he is free indeed and asked to be immediately baptized on the spot to put Satan on the flight, not only from him but from this region too. Surely, he repented and confessed Jesus as his Savior and Lord and to serve Him for the eternity. When he came out of the water, he asked Jesus to allow his wife to stay and rejoice besides him, and for him in heaven,"because it was my fault, but she lived as a godly woman and innocent of this sin". Now she may be accepted in heaven along with him. Instead of being mad at this man as people were before, now were crying and hugging him. Then after, many more broken hearts received Jesus and were baptized, confessing that Jesus is well and alive, walking on the earth among us.
