Romania's South-Eastern area is full of poverty. Pastor Gramada Ministry works there to evangelize and plant churches while trying to put together the broken pieces of the needy people both spiritually, physically and materially.

Mom, Florence Neagu has four kids between ten to two years old. Her husband's company was disbanded due to Covid-19. While visiting the family we found no food in the home and the little ones were begging us for

something to eat. The father was at the river to catch fish for a meal. They were hoping to catch enough to provide at least a meal for his family. They live in a shabby old apartment provided by social service. They still must pay monthly rent to the city. In this they were content and happy to have a roof over their heads, keeping their kids in warmth and safety. The parents everyday are looking for any job. Sometimes the mother works a day job while the father takes care of the kids. It was a great blessing and joy for them when we provided some basic foods and groceries to last for a week. We were sure the father will start to cry when he returns with his couple of fish in hand. Yes, we are still very involved in the Covid-19 Pandemic Season, as the country still struggles with an increasing number of cases.

The church vision over this area is to provide a full basket of survival foods for each family who is in trouble. We are giving one visit every two weeks. This way we make sure at least to provide a part of the meals for these needy families. We try to catch the fish along with them, and if possible to provide the fishing rod too.

The Goal of the Visionary Project is:

Aiding large and poor families whose jobs were lost. Helping the lonely elders who have no one to help.

Supply food, clothing and shoes, schooling supplies for the kids, and renovate, update, clean and painting the dirty unsanitary, and broken homes of these poor families.

This project is how we show mercy to relieve the suffering and the pain of some precious people. The cost of this project is rather high but if the Lord favors to cover it, then He finds the right people, brothers and sisters who will, pray and give.

Evangelism, Conversions and Baptismal Services are a Daily Event

As the economy, the schools, and social movements slow and almost stop, Jesus Christ, has not stopped His church. We share the good news with the lost. We have all the freedom now to herald the Gospel over walls or fences, from our balconies into the streets. We may be six feet from that needy person to rescue and save him or her. And if the one who is reached wants you and me to shake their hands give a hug, we'll not hesitate to hug them. We need to protect others, and in this case, it means to respect the fear in others, and we should do that. However, I spoke with a couple of pastors in Romania and they told me that this pandemic extreme and even oppressive rules for the church are transformed into something good for the church. It reinforces the strength and new strategies and reminds us about the communist restrictive times.

Church planting and meeting the needs of the people are running smooth today, though our visitors from the USA can't travel to be with us, but Jesus always is present. While, inside the church home, we have learned again how to minister in this newly created situation, as

poverty. They don't have anything except their lives and ragged clothes on them. Their food supplies were almost gone. Beds were broken, as well as a few things around like an old table and six chairs that were unsafe

to use.



Cristi is a qualified worker in construction but few jobs are available in the area. He could leave his family and moves to another country, but he can't as his wife has a heart disease and he needs to stay close to her. Cristi, himself grew up as an orphan of both parents and he knows what a hard and lonely life is like. He tries his very best for the kids to stay happy and have a mother to sweeten their hearts.

Our project is to buy them new bed mattresses and some strong wood that a carpenter from the church will craft into beds and chairs for this poor family. We also will purchase for them a gas stove, and provide firewood to heat the home for the winter.

There are many stories to write like this large family whose house foundation was failing to support the column that hold the house up, as it looks the house may collapse on the Sapoi family. These needs are always on the market. And this is mostly because since about a decade I had concentrated my ministry focus on the South, that really may look like the little India inside the rest of Romania. But as well here is the most spiritually needy part of Romania, where people are rightly entitled to hear the good news of Christ who saves and rescues their souls and blesses

their physical lives as well.

Now, Good News about the Camps. We started in homes but local authority's approval for August to start large camps either in large building or smaller outside meetings.
