Thanks for the love relationship with us in Romania proved out by action and good works! However, I always do pray that all our realization here is initiated and done by the Holy Spirit dwelling in us. He leads us to our Father's eternal home where each one's work will be finally rewarded.

Life Center practical ministry fulfills God's will around Timisoara, Romania and ending to reach many parts of the world as well. Evangelism and church planting always stand in front while practically assisting them to bring fulness into their life ministry. There are ministries which branched out from Life Center that are needing our financial support, including ministries in prison, tending to poor families urgent needs while ministering life in Christ in their homes and hearts. We shop for food and clothing, snacks and special gifts that we freely give to them Now it may be our turn to refill their financial tanks as any little assistance from us will help them to go the extra mile while harvesting souls for Christ. Our staff and

students are ministering regularly to a couple of prisons, moreover other prisons were reached out of the large cities around Timisoara. This is one of the pressing projects that I tried to bring out since a few months ago but other emergency needs were first on the line.

Here is a call to continue to intercede in prayer, which we know God hears and answers. We need prayer for the white harvest fields of Romania, but also for our USA offices , volunteers, and financial supporters who minister behind the scenes to reach Romania for Christ. I'm presenting another way to encourage our precious leaders by considering giving special offerings to bless them. But do it only if you're guided by the Holy Spirit to see a special need or project here.

Pray for Niculina, pastor Romulus Paraluta's wife, who was recently was diagnosed with breast cancer. Niculina is set for doctor preparation to get in the hospital for immediate surgery. Pray for her complete healing, including here our busiest field man of God who on this time must both care for his house and children while continuing to do ministry for the house and family of God. They are in a higher pressure needs, both financially and emotionally, since her medical needs sets them back both in time and financial pressures. Pray that Niculina (the mother of seven children) may be healed by the highest doctor Jesus, though the surgeon mind and hands may be used by Him as well.

Pastor, teacher and evangelist Romulus is evangelizing and baptizing people like a continuous conveyer belt line does. I do receive baptism services reports from him like from no one other else. Lately, I started to call him John the Baptist of our times, besides endowed by Jesus anointed ministry as a teacher and disciple maker.

Continue to pray for the eyes of our most diligent lady who serves the house of God too, as sister Calopia, the wife of Gigel, is an expert Cook as well. She continues on special eye injections program trying to save her one eyesight. Now, she sees better and better as the Lord touches her too. Your support helped her out to take this extra special care, as by now the eye deterioration was blocked out.

Besides this is a high mark as their tribulation didn't hinder the work of the Lord but continued the ministry as ever before.
