
We're happy to see these kids coming from the poorest families and poverty areas of Romania not only succeeding but being promoted to new levels of life and society.

My name is Iosif Florea, I'm one of fourteen kids from a large family, consisted of nine boys and five girls. I'm the fifth one born in the family. Today in my parent's home are eight children from the age of twelve to my sister of four. My parents first concern was to raise all of us up well. Money was always short, so we learned to trust God to provide, like shoes and clothing and sometime food. My fathers wages are very low as most of our working area people are out of permanent jobs. My mom is a great house mom and wife. She kept us clean and made sure we're fed. She tries her best to discipline us to be diligent students at whatever school we attended. She tells us that we should be well trained and find better jobs moving to the large

cities. They pray that we'll be successful and prosper in life and not stay poor as they are. When we started schooling she called us her little smart student and a future university graduate.

Their loving prayers did work well. I made good grades in high school but going to an expensive university was just a big dream. Family money is too short to sustain me and the others in the big city's universities. But then I heard about the Life Center and met with a graduate from a Timisoara university who was fully assisted by the Life Center. He encouraged me to apply immediately as their beds are filling up quickly. I did, and by God's grace I was among the first to apply. It took a short process and they accepted me to be part of this great life family center. Most of us are university students, helping and blessing, and praying for one another. What a great home to live in! Here everything was offered and included, conditions of life high above the average. My parents are thanking the Lord for me, and the Life Center and those behind who are assisting this ministry.


Thanks for being a great rescue and help to me. My needs were many and I needed help.

He and his wife Viorica have started Bible Schools, Life Centers, and Church plants in Romania, assisting orphans, teenagers, and providing outreach camps for the most spiritually and physically needy. Today, he develops disciples and leaders, teaching seminars all over Romania.
