This investment is worth it's money, compared with Timisoara the same size house is priced around ninety-thousand dollars. But souls are priced the same before our Lord!

Benea family from Raznic, Dolj

These five precious kids are between five and fourteen year old, and all of them must attend school. The family lives in a small two room house, and their general needs were precarious and needed our immediate attention. This is a new town we reached for Christ, to plant a community church. There were no Christian church in the town. The Benea family was blessed both with shoes for kids and supplies of food.

Sandica Florea is a single mom who raised her two kids by herself with almost no regular income except social welfare. Summer and fall she tries her best to get some harvesting goods from the local farms. These goods are purchased by her own labor, like survival grain for bread to last sparingly until be the next summer harvest. She is gleaning it in the back of the rippers as Ruth did in the fields belonging to Boaz. Our God is good to her. The happiness of following Christ and trusting daily in Him works perfectly, and her kids Mariah and Alex were blessed both with shoes and some clothing.

And here came a miracle for us, as we visited the family, we had a third, pair of shoes in case someone else was in grave need. And there we saw another little boy in the front yard of the home we were visiting. His name was Michael and he was visiting Alex his friend. We introduced one another and found that Michael is from a poor family, one of seven children. Then we asked him if he had any shoes besides his tiny slippers on his feet. Embarrassed, his eyes stirring the ground, he whispered, no I have none, I'm the one in the family who is still lacking a pair of shoes. Immediately, we checked our extra pair of shoes, and there it was, they perfectly fitted Michael's feet. God is always in control over us and the needs of the people around us. We prayed this large family with seven kids will come to know Christ as well!

Peter and Rebeca Tandra family have three girls from four to eight year. Naomi, Maria and Sara, were afraid the shoes may not be available for them. They needed shoes badly because they lacked the money to buy some. But the Lord's church had shown up on their door, telling them that Jesus specially sent us to bring them tree pair of little girl's shoes. When they heard we had shoes for them, they all fell on their knees thanking Jesus who knew their need before telling it to others. Their father was out of work for a long time and the money was scarce to make any other purchases. The parents right on the spot asked their girls to join with them in loud prayer to bless their church leaders, brother John Dolinschi, James Robinson and the other pastors names were told them, their family from America who had contributed to this offering. Here, from a little poor family, blessings were poured out coming out from a humble church as a sacrifice offering before the Lord.

Life Center Great Stories Helping Teenagers

During these hard times we assisted a young girl named Raluca, offering her housing and food. She came from a southern smaller town to receive medical care treatment



in Timisoara. Only a couple of large cities specialized to treat her rare condition.

She cried tears of joy when she found out about Life Center and was approved to be assisted. She comes from a poor family, one of her parent bed ridden. There was no way for them to support her while in Timisoara's hospital care. Thru our Christian doctors she was approved to receive a package of complete

medical assistance to treat her diagnosis of Epicondilita Bilateral affecting elbows, and Cervical Spondiloza.

Recently, we had accepted another young boy who had no one to assist him with anything. Gabi is orphaned of both parents and was raised in a state orphanage. He had successfully enrolled to study in a Timisoara college, and found a part-time job. Today, he is a happy guy with great hope that he is going to make big in life. Until crossed with Life Center he was a hopeless boy and couldn't see any chance for his future. But today he is a happy fulfilled young man.

Life Center daily provides three meals a day to 38-40 young men and women living with us for a couple of years, then they let others in great need take the turn. Additionally, we feed between five to ten other poor children each day, blessing them with hot meals, and other urgent needs like Raluca and Gabi.

Pray for a revival where many lost souls will receive the fulness of Christ! Thanks for standing together with us! Our thanks and prayers for helping Life Center, Timisoara, specially to Life Outreach International, James Robison ministry to the world.

Dorina (lidia) Vlad sent me a thank you letter which I must share this with you:

My name is Dorina, I'm at the age of 56, I'm a church member in Philadelphia church pastored by Romulus Paraluta. As a single mother I had raised four small kids until they had grown up to maturity. The father of my kids left me alone to raise my kids with my own strength and income, and he just got lost in Spain and other countries. He never returned to us as he found a younger girl and stayed with her. I had two boys and two girls, the girls were whole and healthy and married, but not so with my two boys, Iulian and Ovidiu were born with a retarder brain. The diagnosis is under 50 percent of a man's capabilities, mainly this was the cause that my husband went away. Today the boys are at the age of 24 and 27, but mentally they are at the age of 10 to 11. I love them very much, and I refused to remarry so I can raise them with the secure love of a real mother. However, I'm happy that they are not rebellious at all, only fully dependent on



me but good obedient boys who help me with my home tasks and they love me as well. Anyhow, we lived very poor, but with the help of my daughters, while they were grown, we all worked hard to make a living and have a piece of bread on our table, and the boys helped as much as they could. Many times they encouraged me to get my boys in a state orphanage but I refused any of that. It is better we live or die together than separated. But here the miracle of our church came into our little town and their Christ love reached me. Six years ago I had received Jesus my real love. Here for the first time, I felt He loves me unconditionally and from a hardworking mom, but sad and grieved forsaken woman I became a happy lady. I felt blessed by my children and embraced by my brothers and sisters in the Lord. Thanks
