Shoes for Children Blessing

About 200 kids lacking warm shoes mostly coming from the southern-eastern most deprived regions of Romania's Walachia. This rescuing and saving outreach was marched through our fellowship regional leaders and their ministry teams as part of our Churches fellowship and as well Life Center, Timisoara included. Over the last two months the funds were sent to four regional leaders while they got good, discounted prices direct from the factory, We spent about \$3400 solely for shoes for the frozen feet. However, besides the shoe fund other funds were added for clothing, food and meal packs to some depending on each family immediate need. The churches in Romania contributed to these needs too.





The primary purpose of the Life Center ministry is to assist the diligent studious young people coming from very poor families who are not able to support the higher education of their own children after the High School years.

Over the last six months 32 youths were fully supported to study, preparing for a better future. All of these were spiritually trained up to follow God's will on earth, their lives firmly grounded in the Lord. However, a dozen others were partly assisted as their classes were held online out of their own homes; but helped by us in many ways as they were part of the same family of Life Center.

We have a couple of salvations at our Life Center home, and many others received the Gospel thru witnessing on the streets and in churches where we ministered the Word of Life. The Life Center was also involved in wonderful baptismal services where we labored jointly with other church teams.

Bogdan Sarb grew up in the county of Timis orphanage, an orphan. He was received in our Life Center program to prepare and be trained for a better future. education and they wanted to have an opportunity for their girls to have better training. The girls, as well as their siblings, were eager to continue studies on the university level, but were not able to do so without help. They continue to study and are involved at Life Center. Alina studies at the university of medical schooling while Emanuela is studying at the Electronical Telecommunication University. They said, “We are so thankful to all of you who stand behind this Life Center ministry to support the humble and little of us that otherwise are not able to study for a better life future carrier. Besides, we do really enjoy the true life in Christ here both spiritually and physically; as well as

morally and sociologically. Here our life dreams are being fulfilled, thanks to God and thanks to you all, our staff as well as to John Dolinschi our founder and mediator. Especially, to Life Outreach International who are still supporting the fullness of life here in Romania.”

This is how we reach one by one for the Kingdom of God outreaches, not working for a denomination or our organization but just give it all back to Jesus.
