As you know, any donation toward children is 100 percent used for this purpose only. The same rule is for all the other projects, ministries or ministers support, unless designed wherever most needed as any special emergency needs in Romania or given to our general operational fund.



Let me present you, an abbreviated story: Mitica Dragomir, who we reached out to earlier, was a 10-year boy who came from a broken shattered family, first dropped by his father, then by his mother; later on transferred from family to family (grandparents, aunts, etc). However, his hopeless abandonment and loneliness ended when got connected to us, first attending one of the Oltenia camps. From here on, though his plight continued, he was filled with the hope of the real life, from the children's camp he progressed to younger men's camps, was baptized and trained for the Life ministry and a career. Today, serving in a church in Spain, his job is a qualified builder who can do it from start to finish. He's happily married and loves to cherish for a large family.

This is just a glimpse how these precious kids may be rescued and saved, directly gripped in the Father's hand from this life into the ever to live.

Then together let's act on doing something to change a precious life, today!

Philadelphia church of Urziceni just envisioned a heartily project named; the "Kingdom of God enlargement around us" The church is in one of the most arid regions of southeastern Romania, both physically and spiritually. For years witchcraft has been part of the culture. Now we all know that Christ mandated the church to break into the gates of hell and deliver the prisoners free, lifting the King of the kings authority and proclaiming the salvation of their souls.



Our vision is clear, evangelize and plant a church to disciple, teach, train and equip those rescued to reach others. Primarily, enhance evangelism from person to person, besides organizing marketing evangelism, as well public open-air meetings where people are more attracted and daring to attend on hearing God's Word. This means to take town by town,

especially reaching towns lacking any known Christian church and poor souls who may have never heard the message of salvation.

Assuredly, we will need finances to accomplish this ministerial outreach. Expenses include brining in evangelistic preachers and music groups from other parts of the country where Christianity is more dense and stronger than the few of us living on this barren part of Romania. Besides, we'll love to have our friends from America to give a helping hand since the American church makes a deeper impact on our own society. We'll need to provide Bible literature as Bibles and



New Testaments, salvation and first steps booklets to blessing the hungry souls. Afterwards a follow-up ministry among them is needed, it is an important expense of our personal and public evangelism. We'll be able to get these types of books from our publishing houses here in Romania.

This outreach ministry needs a transportation van so we don't need to borrow transportation while we have outreaches to the needy people around us. The usual price to purchase a used one here in the country is around \$18,000.00
