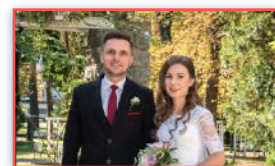

Here I would love to send you a special report about Life Center in Timisoara. Today this ministry represents the overall ministry of what has been done, and what we're still doing in Romania. It is connected to Life in the Spirit of growth to maturity.



This younger generation had been raised from a child to maturity. They practice abundant life that is love for our neighbor. This same principal is happening for the new disciplined leader who are growing up. This new breed of pastors and leaders are growing to maturity but still need our help. All of them are still needing the touching care of us as we're representing Christ walking on the earth, to encourage, teach, help and support, and our finances.

The Life Center is a perfect presentation of the overall ministries in Romania

Here are the reports about this ministry from director Constantin Prisacaru, and his assistant Gelu Golea.

The Life Center ministry houses and trains up at least 41 young men and women in their later teenage years. We launch them into their adult full age maturity. The real number reaches to over 50 who are receiving daily assistance of food, cloth, shoes, and counseling. Most of these non residents have graduated from Life Center, while others receive help because they are in grave need of it. Daily a couple of graduated guests visit with us, and fellowships with us over a lunch or dinner. Life Center also provides wonderful student facilities for classrooms, fitness areas, table tennis and body building. Additionally we offering counseling, fellowship and Bible Studies, musical and singing classes, praise and worship fellowship times.

Lately, we had been blessed to have John Dolinschi teaching a class on ***knowing the voice of God*** and following His prescribed life destiny for us.

The regular caregiver work we do for our Life Center

During November and December, some former students will help the new ones get oriented with Life Center's standard statues and rules. They will be working in order to keep our home in good shape, both inside and out. Their own rooms, kitchen and classrooms must be kept clean and looking neat.

They will learn to keep up with the timely schedule, like meals time, chapel service, and other added programs and outreaches. They will be feeding the homeless, ministering in prisons, evangelism, church planting, and more. We follow up with their schools and universities attendance and keeping a timely program for their homework studies and everything else required of them. We also evaluate the student's grade level, and help those who are behind the average standard.

Today we feature Felicia Dumitras. We helped her from the beginning until she graduated from the Education Academical College and at the same time graduated from Life Center over a year ago. Felicia is from a very large and

poor family, from the unprivileged broken area of Romania. But today she works a very well paid teacher's job she really loves. She is involved in teaching at Gate Church in Timisoara. Here she met George a wonderful man of God, and she married her lover on September 22, 2019

Testimony of God's reaching grace using you and us to shape the lives of people

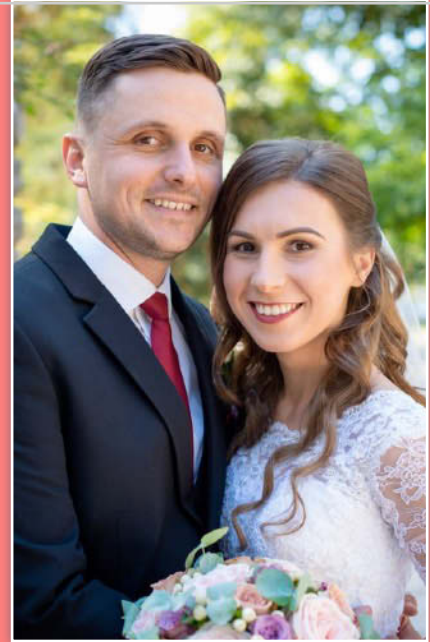

We are supporting one another, in this best tranquil conditions, a lot better than even in our own little family homes.

I'm part of Life Center ministry team of reaching the small village churches, providing peaching, teaching and singing for these new church believers and church plants around Timisoara.

This is what I already had been doing before coming to Timisoara, we reached out to church plants started by our pastors who are backed up by the pastoral fellowship ministry of Pastor John Dolinschi. Pastor John had envision church plants around Romania, and discipling schools to raise new leaders in the ministry. As in our spiritual deserted areas, few believers are around and we are lacking preachers and leaders to go on the harvesting outreaches.
