New groups of children were gathered at several summer camps at different localities, like, Gangiova, Salcia, Carcenii, and Valea lui Patru, and other in Motru area. Our pastors, and our regional children were not afraid of the coronavirus. Their bold courage with our faith worked well as none of our children or youth had been infected in anyway by any virus or any kind of sickness while at the camps.

While we gathered the daily camps around God's word, and by song and prayers, we also used performance sports and shows. Each one was encouraged to learn and practice a healthy - wholeness kit. While serving the meals they were blessed with healthy nutrient kits, and healthy snacks they don't get in their homes. Most of these kids came from under poverty level families, as this year outreach goal was specially meant for them. By each day's end the children were returned back home. A few were housed in our homes or ministry headquarters.

Besides, this blessed daily outreach each child received new school supplies. Most of these kids lacked schoolbags or professional student and pulpit's satchels. This really produced lots of joy and excitement among



the kids as many never had a school back pack of their own. Moreover, some needing the notebooks and written literature and schoolbooks for this new school year. Romania is under some pandemic rules and restriction, like wearing a mask and the social distance.

Over the region overseen by Pastor Romulus there were distributed 40 fully equipped schoolbags, 700 required school notebooks and text books, and several hundred pens and pencils too. This brought much fulfillment joy to the parents as they felt relieved from the extra student expenses.

The children from Gypsy families of Gangiova and their parents were so impressed and amazed about this generosity made to them. Some of them felt the love of Christ for the first time. Besides the school supplies they were craving to get a Bible and bible literature and guiding ways how to read and learn from the Bible. The problem was that many of these kids spoke only the Gypsies language but hardly could understand Romanian, however, they wanted to be taught to speak and write Romanian. Here is much to do from start to finish, the work demand at times overwhelms us, taken us by surprise as we see all around us the fields are white to harvest but our labors are just a few. Please pray for Christ laborers on the field of ministry. Most children from Carceni are of Gypsy nationality as well, but here we

have spent much more time ministering with them, and most of them speak Romanian as well.

In the town of Salcia, we still have lots of opposition from the Orthodox priest and the town's leaders.

Also opposing us are some people who worship witchcraft. They are addicted to it. But the Spirit moved, and we made inroads reaching the children who, in turn, reached their parents. But some parents are afraid because we too easily indoctrinate their children and some of them are not allowing the kids to come to us. However, the ones who came are committed and love Jesus, and their lives had changed, becoming a living testimony for this ungodly township.

Gypsy Church Building Needed

Boranesti is a gypsy town in the south-east of Romania which is Pastor Costel Gramada area of ministry. He is the church founder and overseer of the whole churches area. Years ago, the church had a rough hard start with just a couple of believers, and soon after shifted into the multiplication mode, growing very quickly most with the children, teenagers, and joined by their moms. Later on, were added to the church all ages of women and men as well. And the church experienced a fast growth and soon needed a building, at first the space seemed to be more than



enough. But today the church membership has doubled and actually at times the people jams inside doubling the church seats so people are standing around to hear the message. In the summer season and shiny days the church moves outside for services but in the winter and rainy days we need to be sheltered under a warm roof. Now, everyone is concerned about the coming colder season, wondering if they will be able to attend the Sunday morning services as the Sanctuary is too small to fit all people.

The church has a good central located piece of land just enough to build a new simple but well done building. The problem is the church income is really down because the fewer jobs available are poorly paid. Any assistance will be a great blessing for them. The project cover is within tens of thousand dollars, the estimation is for about \$90.000, but the church will do their very best to cover 25 percent from the total amount.
