Here a couple of summer camps Testimonies of the blessed children:

This year God gave us special favor and the trust to lead, guide and guard the public-school poor kids who joined up with our church children from the Dolj County area. Over many years the government school staff got to know our good name as many children were blessed, changed in good behavioral kids. Here our pastors and church staff were credited as best campers and with much experience in the field. This time they let us use the best government premises in the gorgeous mountain area of Gorj County.

Our camp leaders had a wonderful time to share the good news of Jesus love with each child. Our church kids shared their hearts of joy with the unbelieving precious kids who had been befriended one by one. We have a heavenly atmosphere over all the seven days in the camp. The teaching Bible topic was joy in the Kingdom of God among us while on the earth. Also, the children joined us in the Bible songs we sang, taught to pray before the daily meals, they heard Bible poetry and educational games. Some of the school kids wanted to come closer to us, telling us that they are feeling better than any time before, and they love living a life with Jesus as we do here. Most of these precious kids promised that from now on they are going to live closer to Jesus. However, we were not able to make public altar calls to commit their lives to Jesus as this was the initial rule made by the school Director. Instead, we shared Jesus stories, and prayed one by one with all those who wanted to give their lives to Christ.

Christina came to us in tears as was impacted by the Word of God with tears and committed her life to follow Jesus asking to pray with her.

Marius, a 11-year-old boy couldn't who fight heavy head aches, while in the camp he had severe headaches; he was crying at times. The school medical people who were with us treated him with more medicine, but the pain was persistent and didn't leave the boy's head. They were talking about taking him to the hospital. Pastor Relu intervened and asked if he could pray for the boy's healing. Desperately, they accepted to do it and in about 5 minutes the boy jumped out of his seat confessing that the pain completely left his head, for the rest of the camp the boy

was fine and happy. This boy so far never had seen inside a church, from now on he will be part of it. The seed was sown, the miracles were taking place, and the children and people's hearts never be the same again. The Lord knows better how to draw people to Him!





Now, we paid some kids expenses as their poor parents didn't have the money to support their camp expense to the school as were. However, our support from America made the difference in their little world. This is what our cheerful mercy does when partnerships with the love of God to reach, save, heal and bless our neighbors around us.

Besides the joint school-church camp there were other regional camps running on different days, in the towns around Salcia, Valea Lui Patru, where other 100 kids were blessed.

On these ones the unsaved kids publicly committed their lives to Jesus, got stories of deliverance, salvation and healing took place without any hindrance.

Actually, Gangiova camp is still running, here mostly with Gypsy children, living in a poor Gypsy community in mountain and hilly areas around Gangiova town who are needing Christ mercy and deliverance. Praise the Lord, here we have a fast growing Gypsy newly planted church going strongly. For several years among the Gypsy population is an ongoing revival. The Lord draws these simple poor people to Him, changing forever their lives. Here beside providential charity and evangelism outreaches we're teaching hygienical and satisfied living. We also provide gardening and farming training and skills, tilling their best land available so it may yield sustaining crops for them.



We also provided a couple of young barbers offering the kids free haircuts. Hey, it is much to do on the white fields as the harvest field is large but the workers are still a few. We do also try to send the poor family's kids to school as they are

lacking the basic school training; and we purchased their school necessities for them so they may have a chance to be educated. Here the camp still needs more providential support as some current needs may be left uncovered. Please pray for the miracles to happen, as we know the Lord is our mighty provider!



Assisting with emergency needs:

Wife of our dedicated church planter pastor Stelian was in great pain with her vertical column, she hardly moved around, and needed special investigation but the State hospitals waiting list was for about a year. Consequently, she needed to go to a private clinic. Praise God, we have available this Romania special needs fund, and we were able to pay for her consultation and analysis. Now she is under special treatment, but she may still need surgery if the treatment doesn't work.

Two families from Salcea were in an emergency need of water as the homes were not connected to the town water. We supported the pipe and extension and plugging expense to the city potable water. These were not yet believing families, but now they are attending our new planted believers church in the town as one by one are receiving the Lord, and asking for water baptism.

About a dozen poor large families with kids were assisted with the basic foods as they lived on the edge of survival. We purchased for them the needed food and some bathroom washing utensils and basic needs too.

God is good with us, sometimes we see the multiplication of goods coming right from our own hands. There is more to do, but we'll do whatever be able to make this world a better place to live where our Creator is invited inside our loneliness and poverty.

Sure, we are not alone but the Lord is with us, let's move along with Him, and be His mouth and hands for the ministry to the people!

Please pray for our family as starting with September through the end of the year we'll be in Romania, pray for protection and safety as well to reach as many people as possible. And specially change the church leadership to get down, hands dirty, so the work set ahead of us be well done and accomplished.
