This time, fifty-eight newcomers from those who don't go to church responded. There was another twenty two believers who came and befriended these new

comers. Forty four of the newcomers wanted to receive prayer, visits and information about this life changing power. Twenty-eight people received Jesus as their personal Saviour and Lord, after the Gospel of salvation was preached.

Elena Grigore said, this was a wonderful evening filled with a spirit of tranquility, **I felt so peaceful and secure here.** I would really like to get more information and knowledge about this new life I just experienced.

Gabriela Modoran with tears in her eyes confesses: Here I felt as never before in my life, in only one night I received more peace than any other time in my life. And I know from the inside out, this is what God wants me to do; I give my life to Christ and for the rest of my life I'm dedicated myself to serve Him, whatever the consequences may be, persecuted or beaten, I'm willing to die for this Jesus!

Over the year of 2010, we have Reached over 3000 persons within the evangelistic outreaches and through our young, but still small churches.

About 500 souls received Jesus in their lives, Jesus as their personal Saviour and Lord.

Fifty-seven individuals were water baptized, and filled with the Holy Spirit.

We planted four new churches in locations where there was not any church before.

We ordained three new pastors, and raised and trained six new leaders.

Ten new missionaries were added to the ministry through the leadership training programs.

Hundreds of poor kids, and poor families were reached through the assistance programs.

All our people and leaders were trained through the Discipleship Bible Schools, Bible seminars and conferences, so they can be a live part of the ministry, according to Eph. 4 : 12, 13, for the training of the saints in the work of the ministry..., until we all reach... to the stature of Christ.

Here is a testimony of another girl who came from the same area of Oltenia:



We have a wonderful girl by the name of Sefora Mestereaga, who's from a family of 12 children, who became an orphan as her mother died and left only the father to take care of the children.

Her father worked very hard to provide, care and educate the children. They lived on the edge of survival, nothing

was taken for granted, and all the children needed to get involved, and help one another. Sefora from a very young age as a girl was learning to cook, clean and wash clothes. But though she was busy working hard within the home, above all she was endowed with wisdom, in school she was an excellent student. Her teachers encouraged her to go to high school, but her father needed her help in the home, and did not fully agree to let her go. At last she dared and registered for high school. After graduation, she worked hard, using her abilities to learn new things. She became very industrious and got a job in a medical clinic right in her own town. The doctor and the assistants soon recognized her gifted abilities of learning, and encouraged her to go to medical school. This was an impossibility for her, as the family burden was much on her shoulders. Financially speaking, this was a big mountain, as her family lived in dire poverty, and she used her own salary to buy food and clothing for her father's house. She dared to believe God and prayed and set it before Him.



The miracle of her life happened, as the Lord's hands were laid to bless her.

We heard and learned about her hard situation, and by the help of our local pastors we got in direct contact with her, and encouraged her to continue a college education, and to envision a life career.

She came to the Life Center, and though it was hard to leave her family behind, by our counseling and assistance she saw this as a heavenly provision set up on her own table. She confirmed that in the past the Lord spoke to her about a new door that she needed to enter.

Now, she is in medical school, where she is still the best, and the first, getting promotions, and because of her performance she even gets paid a little bit. She is very blessed here at the Life Center as she doesn't have to pay for food or rent, otherwise it would have been impossible for her to study in a large and very expensive city like Timisoara.

Sefora is not only doing great at the university, but she is very involved in the Life Center ministry, doing all of kinds of jobs, as she is someone that could be most trusted. She is like a big sister to the Life Center kids. She corrects, counsels, helps and comforts them. She also helps with the campus' medical needs.

We continue to assist her, and encourage her, and give her time for her school homework. We try to be her very best parents, as she missed the opportunity to have a happy childhood. We see her becoming a very knowledgeable doctor

and loving to help the poor, and the little children.

The Lord is always in the business of changing lives to make this world a better place to live, a place that is filled with praises and thanksgivings to our God, the Creator who is our own Father. Yes we together, move like an army to bring haven closer to earth. It may be one person at a time, but together we will trust in Him to finish what He began in us!
