I know this man of God in Romania, Pastor Iuliu Centea, since the early nineties. We have the same vision of a definite purposefully ministry. When I first met him it was at our second CCFR youth camp. In 1994 he was a youth leader who led the largest youth team from Transylvania. He still is a very sincere and a steady man of integrity who loves God and adores His people. Today he identifies me as his spiritual father in the Lord. Iuliu is a highly educated man with great passion to know deeper and deeper the Lord, and willingly, risking to step out in obedient faith through unknown waters. This is what a disciple is supposed to do.

Today, Pastor Iuliu is a Bible director over 1300 Christian high school students in the city of Oradea, where besides directing the Bible teaching is teaching other courses.

Brother Iuliu, himself, made many great disciples, about 15 of them being raised as pastors and church leaders. He is a most wanted teacher in Bible seminars and youth meetings, and over the years has impacted about 3000 young people to bring them closer to the Lord. He is one of our youth camps most favorite speakers.

He along with his ministry team evangelized and planted several churches. Last year I joined him to dedicate a new church and building in the town of Vasad, a mix of Hungarian, Romanian and Gypsy church that stands strong in the unity and love of the Spirit.

Pastor Iuliu was the first who stood beside me to found the Pastoral Fellowship of Christian leaders, and since then we have helped to train several hundred leaders in a variety of leadership training programs as leadership seminars, conferences and discipleship schools.

Pastor Iuliu is also the weekly host at Credo TV "The Christian at the present time" the Christian show that's broadcast all over Romania.

Here is another great church leader story.

I just received fresh news from Pastor Romulus who sent a praise report of what the Lord is doing in their midst. Last year seven new ordained leaders were added to our ministry team, and we started four new churches, over the last year, 70 poor families who were on the edge of survival being assisted with food, clothing and shoes, and around 80 orphans and widows became part of our emergency needs list, and were helped with meals and clothing. In our churches alone 110 kids were shoed, this project was done through the CCFR-LOI Christmas shoe project.

Pastor Ignat, reports of a harvest of souls while building the church.

The new church planted here made great progress in reaching out the unsaved, this was done by the word, love and works. Most village people were saved in the process of building the church when they saw the love commitment of the new believers. Just about everyone got involved, men were doing different qualified or unqualified jobs and tasks on the building, the ladies were present to bring food and cooked meals from their homes, and feed the workers. The unsaved came by and inquiring how

much these people are paid to do the great master work, and usually the answer came; we do this for the love of Jesus, freely we received freely we give as this is our home as well, we build a home for the family of God.

Later some villagers came to join and give a hand of help. In the meantime many of these were saved and started to attend the church meetings as well, baptized and became family members.

The money was provided to buy the materials but the work was mostly done by the new believers who are still in love with Jesus. Only here and there did they use a professional builder who led and trained others how to do help. Every one passing by says the building is very well done and a piece of art. Pastor George Ignat and everyone asked to send their love greetings to the American brothers and Christ For the Nations for their help with the roof and to stand with them to build it. And they promised that very soon they believe all the seats of the church will be filled up with a new harvest of souls traveling with them to spend eternity with the Father.

Though the town is very poor they are seeing God's hand on it. They see the difference to be friends with Jesus, the rain comes in season and their gardens produce more than they used to. And though, they spent time working on the church building, by a divine provision their needs are being met, and being taken care of.



Life Center, Rescuing lives of the youth

I'm Catalin Prichici, and I came from the town of Deva, Hunedoara county. By God's loving grace I'm at Electro technical University here in Timisoara. I'm from a family of 13 kids, and I'm the oldest among them. My father lost his job and he gets some unemployed benefits but it is just a little to help with the family's many expenses. He is not sure if he will find another

permanent job in the town, as lots of men are unemployed in our area. My mother is taking care of the home, cooking for us and takes time to give us a godly up-raising and life disciplines.

My parents wanted and prayed that I'll be provided somehow the money to get a college education. My mother always taught us and used to say: I want my kids to succeed in life, not like us the parents. Then, thinking and praying they found a close relative of ours who lives in the village of Jebel, 30 km away from Timisoara, My uncle lets me stay with them, and ride a bus back and forth to Timisoara university. I apply and I was admitted at the Electro University, but later because of lack of customers the bus changed the daily schedule to every the other day, and not early enough for me. I was ready to give up my schooling, unable to attend as I should. I shared my pain with a few of my friends But while talking my hurts out, one of my friends knew about the Life Center ministry, and encouraged me to give them a try before I made an unpardonable mistake, and he provided for me the Life Center phone number. PTL! On my first call I got the chance to speak directly with the director, Costel Prisacaru, he asked me, immediately to fill an application and write down my story, about my family and the financial problems I encounter. I did it with all of my heart with tears and prayers . I asked God to have mercy on me and not to lose everything my parents invested, and to give me hope to succeed in life.



In a couple of days, brother Costel called me and said, Catalin, we give thanks to God, you are accepted in the Life Center assistance program. Isn't the Lord good to you? I said, yes, thank God and you and the Life Center who listen to His leading. The next day, I was given a room and a bed at life center, and I was taken care of any small need I had. I praised God as I felt I that at last I have a home with my own family in Christ. A rescuing miracle happened to me it was like in good dream that came true. I don't have words to thank my Lord, to the Life Center staff and the family here, but as well to Life Outreach International and Christ Commission For Romania who made possible this great home, and helps us to get where God destined us to arrive in life. This is a great building home, with the best commodities in this city, a very loving and clean place in the world, eating better than at our parental homes, providing three delicious meals offered to us each day, what a blessing!
