SUMMER CAMPS

Summer camps projects are being accomplished. A couple of hundred children and youth again were amazingly blessed by receiving salvation, physical and soul wounds healed. They were satisfied with delicious meals, games, worshiping songs and everyone received individual special prayer. We do believe to meet these small children later, serving the Lord, blessed with fullness of life, men and women of God who will inherit the Kingdom of God on earth and in heaven.

PRAISE REPORT TESTIMONIES: Two Brothers Costica and Sandu from Valea Mare village. Where they live, where are no evangelical believers, They come from a very



poor family, all they own is a small shabby home and a small garden around the house, where they plant every vegetable that will grow in the area. They water the garden by carrying buckets of water from the nearby brook. Pastor Florin says; I always observed the teenage brothers stopping and making the cross sign when passing by the Orthodox church. They were seeking for God, and were willing to find the truth and know about Jesus. They work by day at any kind of jobs to sustain family needs.

I stopped in their village and chatted with them, and then visited the hard living family. We paid for their camp expenses to make it possible that they be allowed to spend a week at our summer camps. The Lord touched their hearts at the camp and they committed their little lives to Christ, as the sinner prayer was done with tears in their eyes. When we returned them back home, their parents were glad that their kids accepted Christ and from now on will be His own servants. Just a couple of days ago, I met their mom and she was amazed at the positive change in her kids. She thanked us for investing the love of Jesus in her own children which are now encouraging their parents to live gladly on this earth. The parents said they never heard the message of salvation and things about Jesus before. But seeing the difference in their kids they now listen to them.

Georgiana Tenchiu is a 10 year old girl from Orsova, Oltenia. Her story is one of grave tragedy, her mother was addict to alcohol, and much strife came out from this addiction. Her father scolded and at times beat his wife, and this heavy toll ended when her father killed her mother.

With this tragedy the parents love came to an abrupt end, and the life hope ended in Georgiana's life too.



Her mother went to the grave and her father went to prison, the little girl was taken by the child protection orphanage and later was allowed to be fostered by her own aunt. Her aunt was very poor, and Georgiana continued to struggle with her life, with out love and no hope for her future. Pastor Ludovic saw the girl at times on the street, and started to give her treats and purchase meals for her, but always praying that she should be rescued and saved. She started to come and attend children church services in Orsova. It was a great joy to for us to have her, and bundle her with love and inspire joy in her sadden eyes and face. We caught her heart and love for Jesus. This summer she was taken to CCFR Oltenia camp. For her the camp was the highest joy she ever lived, at the end we asked her, what she liked the most, she said, everything and every moment was a future dream of a life. She loved the Bible hero stories, and from the time they were poor and unloved children like her but God made them outstanding.

She is so happy to meet the family of God and their unconditional love, and she loves to make the right life choices, and she will ask us to confirm if she takes the right ones. And she is assured that in unity with God she can do great things and be used in whatever He sees fit for her.

Lately, we received a letter from her aunt thanking us for taking her to the camp, and she wrote that Georgiana brings overwhelming joy to her also, so she is going to seek her strong God as well.

Florin (left) comes from a family that lives beneath a deep poverty level. He confessed that he has insecurity about tomorrow and what food they will eat. His mom suffers from severe epilepsy and her mental deficiency is deteriorating rapidly. They live in a small shabby home on a remote part of a hill that is only accessible by a walking path. In the home they don't have electricity, they use a portable oil lamp. Providing food for family and fire wood to heat the home is a hard task.



Florin was so happy to be at the summer camp, everything for him there was regally, like living in a mansion though he slept like all others in a tent, but food was unbelievable tasteful and plenty. He said so far, I have never eaten so much and so good and without being afraid it would be gone. One night Pastor Florin saw him in the big meeting tent praying and crying for a long time on his kneels, and asked him why he was crying. Florin said he was praying and crying for Jesus who suffered and died for him on the cross. He realized that he should have no real reason to complain that he lives a hard life as Jesus paid hardly for him to be saved.

When he returned home, he asked his parents if they would allow him to become a believer and a servant of Jesus who died for him, and the parents agreed with him, and said they may go together to see about this Jesus he met, and made another man of him.

Above I laid down just a couple of testimonies, many of these miracle kids came to the camp because our ambassadors were on the street working with the church planting, and the precious needy kids were just found and taken in God's care.

When you invest into a project like this, you invest in multiple ways from poverty to riches, bringing the hopeless to the eternal hope, and it's going straight to the salvation of the precious souls, rescue and provision. Primarily this life center church will invest in educational programs, raising and training leaders, as you know if you have a true Christ-life leader you'll have another strong ministry, a new plant church, souls rescued and saved for eternity.

LIFE CENTER OUTREACH MINISTRY

Life Center feeds up to 44 young men and women daily, in the orphans and street kids outreach we feed them a weekly meal and minister godly counsel to them, morally, spiritually and socially.



Once a month we schedule a special day to feed the street people, orphans and the very poor that are always hungry and lacking hot meals. We fed 107 hungry people and kids at one time, offered them a hot meal, and after it we had a life songs concert and committed them into Jesus' hands. They were so blessed, some with tears in their eyes, and many said they had the best meal in their life, and they felt they were treated like kings and queens and they had the best time in their lives. We had truly enjoyed we could go by faith and make it happen, so everyone of us was blessed and left joyfully.

The church of Cordun and Orsova Oltenia had associated together to bring the lonely and needy widows together. MOTRU CHURCH PROJECT

Pastor Milo's great need at this time is to furnish the new church building with chairs.

Otherwise, the church stands almost finished and ready for use, this church building will be a great Christian Life Center for the south-west of Romania by housing multiple functional ministries in it.

This area is the most needed evangelical mission field in Romania. Oltenia, the historical Walachia group of people living today on the south of Romania, Bulgaria and Serbia that is the most unreached tribe of people in Europe. More and more Walachians are discovering the oasis of life, people finds food, salvation and life and peace, all a blessing from God. We're specially favored by the Spirit of God who moves among us, and the town and the villages are prospering in the blessings from God.

The first building right by the street, we built on the property, and where the church is housed today was designed to be a children and youth fellowship club and also an outreach ministry to the younger generation of Motru city and surroundings.



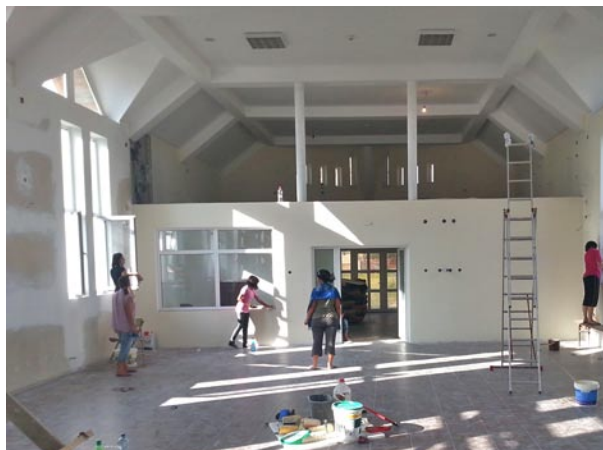
The Apostolic church, Rock of Life that was planted a few years ago in this first small building, has now become too small to house the growing Life Church, so we're looking to get into the new spacious auditorium, and let the youth and children ministry excel and expand into the building that in the first place belongs to them.

The time is just ripe to reach out to the new generations that are hungry and seeking for truth and life, and we need to be seasonally sensible and get them now.



We need about 300 chairs to move the growing church into the new building, and we don't have left anyone to turn to but only to God and beseeching you to side with us in prayer, hoping that the Lord will lift someone up to come and say here I can honor God and help you with it.

The chair project is for about \$8000.



This reminds me about when we first laid the foundation of this building, and the faith seed of ten thousand dollars just came and the building miraculously started, and the Word says that Lord will finish what He began in us, the work He started in us and with us.
