Summer Camps Praise Report

Here is the praise report from a couple of pastors in Romania who had the poor kids and teenagers of their churches and villages out for the camps.

Pastor Romulus tells that around 60 kids at a time for a couple of days took turns over the month of July. They had really good food and nutritional drinks, and lots of good games that made them laugh.

They enjoyed great Bible lessons and training programs, reading the Bible and memorizing Bible verses. They prayed for each of them and the kids reaching out in prayer to each other. This was a mixed camp with Christian and not Christian kids. The goal of the camp was evangelistic and outreaching.

Jancu, father of the boy named Nelu, thanked our local pastor, telling him that his seven year old son is a different person than he used to be. He has changed and now behaves so nicely. Vast, his other son answer was, daddy our family needs to know the Lord Jesus and attend the new church our pastor opened up here in the village. The father was speechless and didn't know how to process this information, as his kid with an urgency told him what should be done in the family. He said, "I was angry, but looking twice to him I

accepted the challenge, and said, yes boy we may be wrong because we don't go to church and to hear about this big God they told you about."

The father came to the pastor and asked if he and his family could come next Sunday to the church. He was concerned that there would not be enough seats for all of them as the church is small.

The camp ended up with a competition celebration so the kids had a chance to recite Bible verses by memory. The kids who performed, and specially those who were outside the church got nice presents, and the Gospel of John Testament, and they promised to read it daily and continue to memorize their favored Bible verses.

Conclusion, reach out to a kid and his father and in turn the whole family will be saved, serving the good Lord!

The pastors heartily sent their thanks to you for the prayer and financial support, like our dear supporters, to CCFR, LOI and to John Dolinschi who favored to support this poor region of Romania and encouraged us to start summer camps ministry. This work is a great outreach and brings lots of fruit that is seeded and harvested in the summer but feeds us all the year!

Pastor Milo Novacovici camp praise report from his side of the ministry:

Our camp was made of 150 participants, two parts church kids and one part unsaved kids. This was a camp with an evangelistic outreach purpose and what we asked from the beginning was to have presence of the Lord among us. We wanted to make certain that all the kids would be safe and God's will be perfectly fulfilled. The presence of God was so powerful and preeminent that at times everyone was either full of joyful noise or tears of repentance and joy flowing down on their pretty little faces. One by one or in whole groups the ones needing salvation were saved, coming up, hands lifted and gave their lives to Christ.

The little boy Sorin came to thank you and us saying: Thanks for giving me the special favor to attend this wonderful camp. From this point on my life I feel is completed changed. I'll not be the same, God is for real, and today I'm saved and full of joy and the peace of God.

Another boy came and said, the love of God conquered my whole heart and entered inside me. Before I was full of hate, but now I love as never imagined before. There right on the spot the Lord filled him with the Holy spirit, speaking continuously in foreign tongues.

There are many more stories as almost every one of these kids has one. There is no time and paper to bring all of them to you, and there are another two camps on the father south east of Romania from which we'll bring you more news, hopefully in the next newsletter.

Codrut & Andreea who are from Garbovat, Milo's team were saved a few years ago, delivered from a heavy smoking addiction, and soon he became a trustful leader and a devoted hard worker for anything needed in the ministry.



Their hearts are fixed on the people they serve in a couple of nearby little towns. They have a compassionate heart for the little poor kids, orphans and displaced kids who are being taken from broken families.

They pastor their towns with a large practical heart of love. Everyone has a table to fellowship with them, and give their precious time and life substance to them.

Just a couple of months ago they started to prepare a bountiful meal on each Sunday to feed these very poor kids. The kids are undernourished, going without meals. Little by little their love and vision is to extend the feeding program.

Pastor John taught us to practice Life in Christ, and every lesson the students learn providing a hot meal each day of the week.

It takes about \$25 to provide for a meal for the 20 kids they are feeding. A monthly support will help them to provide meals for each child so they will not

be growing with body difficency and unhealthy handicaps. They are in need of at least \$150 monthly.

Thanks to Pastor Scott & Lori Olsen and their team of six from San Antonio. They came here with two young

children who loved so much the youth and the children of Romania. They were a great timely asset for this year camps, the church and other outreaches in Romania. Pastor Milo said, I don't know how we would have made it without them being with us.

Pastor Milo, Romulus, Gigel, Lazar, and many others asked us to not let them down and alone but strengthen them with anointed leaders, pastors, teachers and missionaries from America. This was the spiritual support they were asking for and the financial support that was need.

Life and Job Training Program supplies life provisions to 47 regular students, all of them are like our own kids, they eat three meals a day and all the other expenses and utilities are included. The building houses them in updated facilities where training and Bible classes are held. Also provided is spiritual growth through guidance, advise and counseling, and outreach programs to all kinds of city and the country villages. We could also call this a Life Bible training and mission center of Timisoara, reaching all over Romania.

Together with our staff, students and the father founder Pastor John Dolinschi, we're taken off for life and ministry practicing together church planting, evangelism, and many other good works.

This summer we celebrated our students who graduated from the state and city universities. Most of our students families are too poor and too far away to travel for the event and be present to hug and congratulate the graduate. Along with our being there we bless them with flowers and a special present, and usually we share a special meal together.

Our long time student Dariu Catana graduated from the computer science university, he was our right hand, student class leader and ministry leader. He was the best student with a GPA over "4" we'll miss him greatly. Other leaders like Daniel Oaida, Raul Matea and ten other wonderful young men and women completed the graduation list. Our thanksgiving gratitude goes also to LOI, Dr. James Robison who joined up forces with CCFR to build up this great city Life Center edifice, and continuing to support this great ministry. Our gratitude goes also to all of those who love us enough here to support the Life Center orphan and poor kids ministry in Romania. We're very proud of all of our Life kids that graduate and we would like to bless them at the time they leave us.

We have blessed them and helped them in their real hard life, and we are very positive in return they will bless others as they had been blessed.

In the future we'd love to get a special graduation fund that will be used just for this honorable event. We want to bless each of our precious children to meet their needs and not let them leave empty handed. \$50 for each graduate to cover all that may be a need and blessing memory to them.
