I'm Daniel Tomus, I'm from Deva city, and a family of 18 children. My parents were working hard to care and provide food for us, and this helped me to be a hard worker as well. I wanted to do my very best in high school. I was taught that hard work with hope and purpose for the future will help you to finish well. But it was almost impossible for us to continue my education at the university. I needed to find a good job to make money to pay the university. However, the Lord had better plans for me, really it was a miracle to be accepted at the Timisoara Life Center. It is just a 20 minutes walking from the electro-magnetic technology University where I studied. Now, I successfully graduated and was hired by the electro-equipment industry corporation. I started with a salary of \$480 a month that is a very good monthly income comparing the average salary in Romania, but this will be raised as my experience goes up. This salary is more than double of my father who is working harder and longer, and where I was supposed to work if I couldn't make it through the university. I'm glad for I'll be able to help my brothers and sisters continue their education as well.



Here I want to say thanks to all those who stand behind the Life Center, LOI and CCFR, and other people. You helped turn our lives around into what God intended us to be, successful men and women of God. You helped raise us up into the minister of the Gospel and to turn around and help others who are in need. I feel so blessed today that today I don't have to beg or expect financial help from others but I'm in the position to help others to reach their goals.

My parents and pastor told me about CCFR led by Pastor John Dolinski, a ministry that changed many lives and whole cities in Romania. Long ago we had tent evangelism for weeks in our city, and church planting came from it. A couple of churches have been roofed up by this ministry.

Our Christian youth and even non-Christians from the town attended over many years the national youth camps of CCFR. Thousands of young people were reached, saved, changed forever and blessed with eternal life in Christ.

Today, I hear and see more and more church and ministry leaders are being trained and raised up into the ministry. Statistically church planting in the south-east of Romania is leading the way as the strongest region in the country. This region was completely barren with no Evangelical Christians and no churches. Today the Oltenia region will be the first and not the last one in Romania, no longer the outcast as it used to be named.
