## SHOE PRAISE REPORT CONTINUING TESTIMONIES

e have recently reported to you about the shoe ministry. We want you to understand how the ministries we do tie together. We train leaders to reach the people around them, not just with the spoken word but meeting their physical need. This training is encouraged at all levels, from our kids in the Life Center or at camps, to the Bible schools and the pastor conferences. Meeting the needs of the hurting opens the heart of the people to see Jesus in us. They see that Jesus has hands and feet through our works. They see His heart through our love and they want what we have. God so loved that he gave, so we reach others by giving. The result is souls saved, lives changed, hope takes the place of the hopeless and the Kingdom of God is brought to the people of Romania. When the Kingdom arrives, darkness and evil are put in check.

Many of you have been reading our newsletters for a long time. It is easy to think, "here is just another story". I pray that you don't grow weary doing well. These are real people and you are helping to change their lives.

COSTY is a 11 year old boy coming from a family of nine kids. At this age he knows only about a hard life for his family has much brutality and abuses. His parents are heavy alcoholic, and besides beatings and forced labor, the food is lacking and the clothing is scarce. We're assisting him and others like him. Any time we entered their door we get a big smile from the little ones in the family. They dance with joy. They smell it out, the good tasting meals and snacks that is ready to be served, but

also they are hungry for love. They jumped in our laps and kisses our hands and cheeks, and hugged our necks. They know how to say sweetly, I love you so much.

We gave to each of the little kids a pair of new shoes that made not only their day, but their month and their year. Rejoicing and dancing together they were proud and craved to show up at school the next day and parade their new shoes in front of the other kids.

Before we reached them they missed much school because both of being too hungry and lack of clothes to wear. However today we made a friendship rule with them that in order to stay together they will have to go to the school, and they gladly go. Each Sunday they come and meet with us at the new church planted in their village. They got saved and worship the Lord with their whole little childish strength but big hearts to love the Lord, and their new real family in Christ.

taking care of her one year old brother Peter. She carries the little boy wherever she goes. Their family doesn't have any income, but they work a day here and there wherever they find a job for a little money, so little Angela is taken care of her brother. We came with the little shoe gift to these kids, we found just Angela and her little brother home, when they saw the shoes they start to hug and love it like of a little doll in their hands. Peter was holding and keeping the shoe kissing them. The family, since a year ago started to attend the church, but didn't make a decision until, absorbing the joy of their kids and the peace of God over their home, they decided to follow the Lord.

#### LIFE CENTER MINISTRIES

The youth from here had the same troubled stories as those from the shoes report:

Marinela comes from a family of seven kids, she is the oldest in the family, as a child she grew up in a depressive home. Her parents were fighting most of the time and she blamed herself. She saw that her siblings were sad and depressed like her. Her father died when she was nine, and after that her mother fell in a great depression. Soon after this death her mother was checked in to a mental hospital. Marinela still a little girl, had to take care of her younger siblings and provide for the home as much as she could.

Her mother soon died of cancer and the children were split up into orphanages. Around this time a church had been planted in the village and the pastor got to know Marinela and the plight of her siblings. He encouraged the congregation to reach out to love and help them. By God's help and care the children continued to be schooled. Marinela checked and cared for her brothers and sisters and she still does today. Marinela was accepted to the Life Center to take care for her furthering schooling as she is a very smart and diligent girl. Today she is a good example of integrity and sacrifice, along with the Life Center she continues to help her brothers and sisters. At the Life Center she is trusted and is a leader of others.
