In this news letter, I first would love to bring you the prayer's requests. I do this so you will catch right from the very beginning the heart of what brings us to the Lord. Thanks for your availability and steady commitment to pray for us, your family in Romania.

This February,I felt to pray for the spiritual ministry of Christ in Romania!

First, I remind you about church planting. This is our rollingroll for all of the other outreach ministries. If you light up a church in a town, a village or national community, then the outreaches just spring up into all level of society. I think here in America, we have lost the "church vision and passion". Going to church has become a common thing. This attitude of usually and regular leads to ignored and abandoned, because it doesn't carry the light around which is the change power of every human being. Pastor Relu who is working in Oltneia in close relationship with Pastor Milo, did a miraculously planting of a dozen churches mostly in the Gypsy villages. He is a brother with a burning passion to learn more, rescue the dying poor and save the lost souls who are in close proximity with him. He is always present in our Bible and leadership seminars, and begs to bring his leaders and new disciples with him. He desires to make disciples and to send them out.



This precious man of God was born with inherited eye disease from his father, and needs special glasses to see. The old glasses are no longer good and filmed with dark spots. He can hardly read the Bible in church. He is a great preacher who relies on his memory or someone else to read for him. A new pair of prescribed glasses costs him about \$600, that is a lot in Romania. It's a big sum in the area he lives, but not that much here in the USA.

I pray a precious brother or sister will support this pastor's needs and the great work he is doing for our Lord Jesus Christ.

This new planted church is built with very inexpensive materials and labor as everyone of his people tries to bring a brick or a beam, here is a picture just freshly sent from the white winter of Romania.



The church involves itself with the needs of the poor and downtrodden. They try to help the destitute with whatever they can, a little is multiplied into something greater, and the Lord blessed the pastors and the believers. They are poor themselves but share what they have, in return everyone is blessed from the Lord.

The Oprisan family has five children, the father is an alcoholic and the mother can't understand much and is not able to take care of her kids. The family suffer from cold, hunger and lack of clothing. It is rather a broken family with no purpose or a hope of a better life.

Since a few years ago Pastor Milo and Nina, decided to get involved and help the kids to survive. First they visit them and showed a mother and father's love to the kids. With their visits they brought food and clothing and a steady flow of food. They meet one of these kids in a grocery store looking for something to get or buy. This happen a few times while I was there with Milo.



After some time, the parents continued to be careless and inept to take care of their kids. We are now seeing our investment was profitable. Marian, the oldest son who became like a little caring father for his brothers and sis-

> ters, decided to give his life to Christ and follow Him thoroughly. He became involved in his local church. He sings and is learning to play musical instruments, and rightly, he is a talented musician. Now, he draws all his siblings with him to attend church, and he teaches them the only one way to go is Jesus the Saviour. We're going to see these kids raised up as men and women of worth and much value for others,

and in time minister to the others who are in the same life plight.

Some of these kids will end up in the Life Center of Timisoara where they will study to become life bridges engineers for others. They will become nurses and doctors to heal the broken and the wounded. This is the life church of Christ Commission for Romania. The church is made from former broken puzzled pieces glued and linked together to make a beautiful picture of light to light the sinful world we live in. I do truly hope you'll be a piece in this wonderful puzzle of God making.

Brother Bob and Millynne, Lowell and Sally will be part of it. Brother Dale and Velda, Dale and Evelyn, James and Betty, Larry and Georgianne, Robert and Betty, James and Lynette, Gary and Darlene, David and Linda, Mark and Jill, James and Jill, Terry and Dolores, Mike and Margaret, Gerry and Ethelynn, Joseph and Estrella, Mark and Wendy, Mark and Melinda, Allen and Sharon. And many more others like Richard H. Brian H. Don G, Steve C. Phil C. Morris S. Jackie W. Harley F. Ed H. Julie G. and a lots more who made a difference in the past and others at this present are on the same list that is written on the eternal rewards of heaven for Romania. They together are finishing the line, well done My children!

If Center is continuing to make a big difference like all the other churches, considering these kids came from the same background as the Oprisan family. These kids could be lost in the cold and freezing streets and dying early deaths, and gone forever into the darkness of the eternity they lived for. Today the Life Center's new born want to set all the captives free. They are deeply involved in the street and prison ministry.



Here you have the Life Center students serving in songs, preaching and counseling the men and

women in the prison. Some of the inmates have a life sentence. The Life Center director, Costel Prisacaru was so happy to see their passion and hear God's word uttered through them, explaining to prisoners: You may be in prison for life but if you trust in Jesus you will be free indeed, many more outside are living a hell prison right here in the



darkened free-

dom, and some of them commit suicide. You may be depraved of freedom to roam around the earth and do what you want, however, if you give your life to Christ and do the will of the Lord, you'll enjoy life and be the happiest on the earth, because Christ means freedom, joy and peace.





Let's continue to make disciples, Pastor Milo Novacovici and other pastors who became visionary networkers with CCFR, reports a special new start; "the school of disciples". Jesus commissioned His apostles: "Go and make disciples and teach them to obey" Not, only that, but anyone who came to Jesus He sent them out to tell others the testimony of Jesus. There is a great need to make a disciples from any converts who truly came to Christ, each one is called to a special call that no other can do. As you know the Lord doesn't have substitutes of one to the other. He had created a unique puzzle pieces that set together become a perfect Kingdom picture.


And some prisoners end up in tears other they explode in joy, and others are truly bewildered of what for the first time they could hear.
