First is a praise reports of the church planting and building projects of the past couple of years, and thanks to all who stood behind these great outreaches.

Praise the Lord for the following church buildings:

Garbovat church, the building almost fully complete. I want to deeply bring thanks to the main sponsor who stood behind it: Dayspring Pentcostal church, Pastor Milton and Peggy Spears, and others who participated with donations.

The Rock Church of Motru, the building is over 90 percent completed and fully used by the church. The heating system is still not in. Thanks to Dr. Morris Sheats, Dr. Dale Yerton, Pastor Mark Duke, and Dale & Velda Clark, and others who stood behind this great God's outreach edifice.

The River of Life Church of Orsova, the building is over 50 percent finished but mainly used by the church. Thanks to Dale and Velda Clark and others who were directed by the Lord to freely give to this wonderful church and beautiful town.





Moldoveni Living water Church, is fully completed inside and mostly used by the church but still needs outside finishing work and pavements. Thanks the Lord for a good number of small donors who heartily gave that made this possible.

Boranesti Gypsy town Church, here a home is being purchased and fully modified and remolded, the church already worships in it. Thanks to Rev. Ed Huie who fully supported this expense.

Cornita Church, The building is just finished with the help of it's members and

Desa Pentecostal Church, the building is progressing, but still a permanent roof and final works is to be done. This work was accomplished through many donations that came from inside and outside Romania.

Church, the building is mainly completed. Here the Lord sent a Romanian business man from another town who is not a committed Christian and doesn't attends any church, but he felt deeply that he was responsible before God to put some of his money into this church, we do pray for his salvation and rewarding afterwards. CCFR helped with a couple thousands dollars that was needed to encourage the business man to continue.

Vasad, Light on the

Mountain Church, was recently planted and the building completed. It was a miracle church growth and built right on the border of Hungary. Immediately after the church plant a member donated land and the people started to build. Other offerings helped to jump it step by step until finished. It came with a blessing



as a business man of the town got saved and then generously helped to finish the building. This good investment helps support a pastor with his monthly needs and outreaches that returns back with a multiplied bounty to us.

Here above I presented several church buildings and their main sponsors but to each one we should include the local church body who participated with their little money, and sacrificially volunteered their time to build it. And not only the members but their own pastors working hand on hand together, in fact in Romania the pastor is first in the line to lead the people by example and sacrifice.

All of these churches were first started, gathered in open places and in homes until they found a permanent place to worship the Lord.

New church plants at works. These above churches and their mother churches are continuing to reach out to other towns where no church existed. This becomes a second step after the first step of evangelism outreaches that starts to turn a town from down side into the upside position to receive Christ.

Here are the new locations where last year the church of Jesus Christ expanded its wing of church planting ministry: **Rudesti, Movilita, Cernetul, Bahna, Ilovita**

Here I want to name the senior pastors who envisioned outreaches to all these above towns and villages, and along with CCFR trained leaders who occupy a pastor position for each one of the churches named above: **Senior Pastors; Milo Novacovici, Costel Gramada, Iuliu Centea, Romulus Paraluta, and George Ignat** are all of the southern regional churches. This is the most needy spot. We are pressing on, and invest most of our time and financial support to this area.

The planted church of Secu village projected to build up.

This church was planted a few years ago. Services are outside in the open air, and in the cold season inside the homes. God's timetable came, so we started on a building. Pastor

Florin and Jeanina Scafariu who were the missionary pastor leaders under Pastor Milo Novacovici and Pastor Florin dared to start this church in a very spiritually darkened spot of Oltenia. This area has lots of witchcraft, but no Christian believers. Until reached they were not exposed to the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The zone area is also very poor, in a hilly terrain on unproductive dry lands. Planting a church here was pure compassion for the people who lived both spiritually and materially in poverty. They are in a darkened knowledge environment, hedged down throughout the past centuries by the Ottoman Empire and later by the cruel communism rule. The first faith seed for a church building was set up was by Pastor Curtis & Gayle Lengefeld, and recently a very generous



offering from our dear saints Dale and Velda Clark, who helped to build other churches in Romania. Usually, when we get a backing from outer resources we know God is speaking to us on go ahead and start building. With no bank accounts, and very limited resources from the local people who are hardly able to build anything for them, by faith we start.

Here in Secu village we really are encouraged by the many spiritually hungry kids and youth who socially have nothing else to gather them in one place together, no village activities, no night clubs, but they enjoy hearing about Jesus Christ and learning to sing beautiful Gospel songs with us.

And consider another worthy support need. If we didn't have a church leader in any of these towns then we wouldn't have a church planted, built and finished

Now let's pack up the church planting ministry. Once a station embassy of heaven is set up and a representative of the Kingdom of light is in the office, we know well town's people are being blessed. The orphan are comforted, the widow visited and provided, the broken home are being mended back together, and the kids and the youth are not running away to end up in the bigger cities streets and fall into the human traffickers hands. This is the purpose of the church of Jesus Christ existence to be a Life outreach to the poor, a river of Life to broken hearts, and to pass the bread and multiply the fish to the families table!

Thanks for being a Life prayer chain and sponsor of the Kingdom of heaven, investing into the poor soul's salvation, rescued from a cursed earth and bring the Kingdom blessings right on the same spot, and here you did it!

Now watch out in the March letter I will bring you a good news praise report about what and how these ministers of the Gospel reaches the poor, the orphan, the broken homes kids, public schools, and the mission accomplished by the Life Center ministry. And a thank you to our USA side ministry who are making a steady upgrading difference in Romania for Christ.

I like to keep it short and focused so you may be able to remember well how to pray and help out when the Lord prompts you to do so, and I'm praying you'll be listening and obeying the Holy Spirit that is guiding us in all things.
