As I promised you in our December letter, we'll continue here with the heartily precious children shoes project that is running with us since several years ago, and it can't be finished but it grows and expands.

In a cold and poor country as Romania, warm winter clothing and shoes are a children problem that we must care about. It came very close to my heart when I see kids missing school not only for days but weeks and months. Then usually have to repeat the same year until sooner or later they dropout. As a consequence they follow their in the fathers heritage of poverty.

I do have my own experience that stayed ever in my mind. I was one among the 13 kids in the family, and what I can still remember very well were my cold freezing feet while attending classes at our school, all of the fourth grade I attended a rather unbeated or very little heated school. Adding to my pain, the lack of warming shoes, usually I wore rubber like summer shoes. I remember, sometime I felt and was afraid my toes were frozen. Today I'm thankful to the Lord that I'm walking good, but in my younger years I struggled with aching legs, but His divine healing, I don't carry any of those past cold consequences, I feel healthy and strong.

Oana, Adelin and Ionut are three precious kids of Florin and Mirela Stoichita's family. They live near Filiasi town, a town where some scarce jobs may be found. Most need a bus or train for a daily ride, but this luxury is not provided at their village. The parents work hard for less in whatever they find, working for

Florin Family from Boranesti, the father is handicapped and the mother takes good care of the kids. "I do my best to cook from the little we. When our neighbors need a little work around their houses or I cook for them. This way I can get a little income, but this is real small compared to what we really need, food, clothing and shoes besides this little home needs to be fixed up."

When all of them received the winter shoes, they were truly celebrating. The father said it is good not to see them borrowing one another shoes. my heart hurts when I see but can't help. I really don't need the shoes as I can't get around and walk but it's a pain to see these kids with good legs and they can't walk because the lack of shoe.

worried about buying shoes for the kids for the budget was just not there. Buying shoes for the four kids is a month wage. They knew the best thing to do was to pray and thank the Lord for the shoes and not doubt the faithfulness of God. The shoes came right at their door, they didn't expect or know a thing about this source of provision, but the Lord who knows the needs of each one of us sends His guiding Spirit to reach and touch the cries of His people. Now the

other people, and often they are paid just with food or some clothing. It's a daily struggle for them to feed and clothing their kids. Their children have to walk about a mile to school, and their shoes were a couple of years old, worn out with holes and broken parts. Their father would sew them with thread and wire to keep them on their feet.

The cold and the snow still creeps inside, however, the children get used to their cold feet status. When they received the new shoes everyone was overwhelmed by tears, laughter and joy. It was like they received a rare gift as two of the kids didn't remembering ever having new shoes on their feet.

After we prayed with them and said good bye every child came outside with us to say another thank you, and each was still holding the shoes in their hands, they were excited and wanted to shared their joyful gift with the neighboring kids, telling them about the miracle they just received, telling them how beautiful and warm are their shoes.



Here is the Cotea family, their children are Daniela, Estera, Peter and Sarah, the family is Christian but they fight daily for provision to make ends meet. This is part of their daily prayer, asking and thanking the Lord for the blessings received and other on the way to meet them.

Also we don't feel alone and deserted. And because of this we also understand that our God loves us and knows about us, and hears our prayers.

Their father is really struggling to support the family, he is busy and tired, and sometime get sick, but goes on. He tells that children became his big encouragement, lifting him up with good spirits and encouragement words.

The father is happy as all the kids are attend the school and he speaks proudly of them. Each one makes high grades in the classes, they are good kids and very sweet, I'm sorry they don't have a mother to spend more time with them to comfort and care for them.

Please be a part for you are my friends. Next time when you feel stressed and unhappy, just declare I'm blessed and happy, more blessed than most of the world around me. But do like I did today, when I felt stressed with too much to do, and felt like just running from it. I came to Jesus and declared: I'm truly blessed, more blessed than I ever imagined, praising the Lord for His goodness. After I really felt good and ready for another mile, another month and year until the end of our days.

They just sent me their report and pictures ministering and feeding the homeless living on the street, they truly love to minister to the broken and the very needy.
