Hear the joyful happy man's picture of our dear friend and brother Romulus!

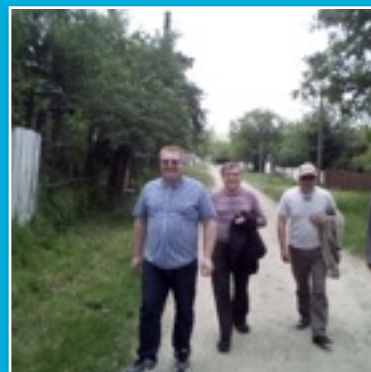

A family in the church of Valea lui Patru is being Blessed. Brother Constantin Dinculeasa



is one of our church leaders in the area. He has seven children and just a little two room house. The children and parents sleep together. This

couple is wonderful team together, sweet souls who really love God and the people around them. The father, Rev. Constantin is a helping hand pastor and preacher, reaching out with love. But they have a physical and material impediment as their old little home is too small to contain this large family. It is really great to be in the process of building a new home for them, what a joy when the children are looking to their new spacious home but still not ready to use. Please let's pray that their little income may be multiplied, and we all may have more to share and finish up the home before the winter sets in. Let's pray for another \$10,000 to come in!

Thanks as you Blessed our Church with a large Washing Machine, there are members in the church that are too old and some incapable of washing their own clothing. We have

scheduled a day or two each week when we'll be washing the needy's clothing.

Part of the fund used for the Valea Lui Patru church, we needed an upgrading inside the church, designing and enlarging the space to put more chairs in it as we're continuing to grow. Here and there people must stand while the church service is in process, and in Romania a church service is about 3 hours at a time.

Thanks to brother Dale and Velda Clark for helping our church to fulfill these projects we listed here above. We feel encouraged and relieved to see the people blessed and happy around us!

The Little Girl Elisa Needs Surgery. From birth she suffered a brachial plexus palsy. An inexperienced doctor fractured her little right hand collarbone and the nerve was severed as a consequence her hand was paralyzed. However, her parents did the best and later started to perform physiotherapy on her hand. By the time she was four year old she had a little general use on her hand but the palm and fingers don't work. The doctor said she should have hand surgery and it may be fully recuperated.

Little Elisa is the niece of our wonderful Pastor Gigel Ignat who is a church pioneer in Piscu Vechi, Oltenia region.

While around, often I saw her grandpa suffering for her unfortunate handicap. I said, let's pray brother George, let's present it and expect a full hand use miracle. George is a great apostle who spends everything for Jesus, the only one over the whole Danube River region, from the start to the end of the river.

About \$900 may be needed for this one surgery, but this amount is a very big deal for them.

Little girl Alexandra Miriam is a 10 year old, she badly needs dental work and braces. Her teeth are deformed and out of place, hurting her jaws and tongue. She was born premature, with special needs and still is in need. She has a wonderful sweet soul, loves her parents and siblings, obedient and a diligent sweetie.

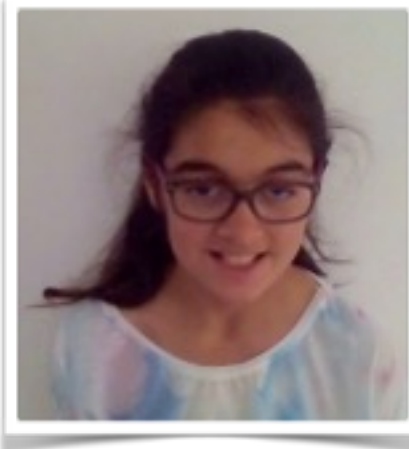
Miriam is the daughter of Pastor Romulus and Niculina Paraluta, the greatest father's heart of any pastor. They are sold out for the Lord.

Close to \$400 may be needed for her complete dental care expense.

Prayer and Project Request for Pastor Nicu and Elena Burtea.

Pastor Nicu works under the leadership of Bishop Milo Novacovici, a great missionary and man of God who moved from the big city of Timisoara to evangelize and plant churches in the Walachia region soon after the fall of the communist regime. Oltenia was the most none-evangelized region of Romania, a vast third part of Romania but with a few Christians and a couple of churches.

Pastor Nicu was among the first disciples he won for Christ, and then he became a leader, a missionary, and himself a church planter. First he had an apartment in the little city of Motru.



But later he was sent by the leadership team, and Burtea family moved out for a mission endeavor in the very south of Oltenia, into the Alexandria area. While there he used his apartment money on the ministry.

He is now back in his native area, but doesn't have a place of their own to stay. They live and move in with people from here to there while his ministry demands are greater than ever.

It will be a great blessing for Nicu and Elena and their three teenager children to get their own home and place to live, at this time they would really love to be centered in the midst of their ministry and works, out in the country of Valea Perilor village.

With between \$15,000 to \$20,000 they can recover what is needed for a house to buy right in the midst where they minister. Please pray and stand with these great team of committed workers for Christ's Kingdom!

There are always more needs, projects and lots of praise reports but the paper I'm writing is short, not because of space and ink or time but because I want you to read it all from the start to the end for today's story!
