SUMMER CAMPS ARE HERE

We're just entering the summer schedule, and hundreds of kids and youth in Romania will be attending the summer camps.

The summer camps will start in the last week of June and go all the way through the month of July, ending by early August. If our whole ministry covered only the 6 weeks of camps, just take into account the salvation and the mending of these little poor but precious souls, who're going to meet Jesus face to face, and then joyfully enter the gates of heaven, it would be worth all the effert.

There are no better rejoicing and bigger rewards that we'll find on the face of this earth, that stirs up even the heaven to celebrate. There is no other comparing value against only one soul being saved. Besides that, many of these kids will be mended and healed from the bruises of their past abuses. The loneness and indifference they suffered at the hands of others or just simply nobody being there to care for them, and never knew the meaning of a true loving hand, God's healing hand will touch.

Lets' feed them well, for some this may be their first time to eat generously as their wants or need are. Remember, when they leave the camps there is a huge difference from the time they entered. This is not only seen in their shining eyes and smiling faces but in the color of their skin, in their puffed red cheeks. Most of them they will leave with a few extra pounds built on them, but it was exactly what they need. Malnourishment among children is rampant in Romania.

LIFE CENTER is making a great difference among the youth of Romania, this is a Life training center, that make life better and sweeter for all of the occupants. You may think of it as a multiple faced training programs, from salvation of souls to all kinds of training programs that elevates people to higher levels of life quality. Our goal is not only to train them but be trainers and reach to others.

Here let me have a word of gratitude and appreciation for the ministry of **Life Outreach International, James and Betty Robinson**, who are the builders and still supporters of this Life Center of Timisoara, as well the initial partners of the Rescue and Prevention Center of Oltenia.

Let's in conclusion hear a poor's girl's life story. She passed through much life training from the world to the church, to the youth camp, and as today to the Life Center. Without these stages she wouldn't have made it to where she is today:

Testimony of Loredana Balaci as she wrote it down:



LOREDANA

Icome out of the poor reigon of Oltenia. My town is on the Danube River across from Bulgaria. One of my sisters and I lived with our grandparents as my parents had no jobs because of health issues. As a teenager, I attend a couple of summer camps that was sponsored by Christ For Oltenia Ministry which is led by Pastor Milo Novacovici.

Now let me make her story short.

From her early childhood, Loredana was a courageous child. She kept busy and work hard to make ends met. She wanted to succeed in life and became a very diligent student even getting herself into High School. This is rare for kids of her village. High School was located a few miles walk for her. Loredana advanced in High School with a medical side of studies. She graduated

and volunteered to a local family clinic. Because of her diligence, the doctor rewarded her now and then with bonus money.

She also ministered to a Gypsies village, to a people who are living under poverty level. She used this time to teach them about Jesus, and her own testi-

mony of being raised in poverty and lacked the basic needs of life. She told them of Jesus her provider and the love she never had before.

Loredana was praying to go further with her college

education, and prayed if this is the Lord's will, she would get the money to get her the next step, travel expenses and a first start to a university. Then a brother who was unknown to her, gave her money to be used for her education. She knew that this was a sign from God. But she was perplexed where to go, as the colleges were all far from her village, and still wondering, if once accepted, how she would get funds for rent, food, etc.

Back to Loredana own words

Then Pastor John Dolinschi visited our town and taught in our church, and I felt from the Lord to approached him, and told him my story, that I'm praying to find a college, but I don't know where and how will come about. He was a much needed guide help for me. He said right away, girl you should come to Timisoara where there are outstanding colleges and universities of this country. You'll have a home there and the family at the Life Center, where by God's grace you may be admitted. You will

have assistence, once in the program, we'll give a good start for the two years at least, then we'll evaluate again your situation.

I did, and here I have a real family where I'm loved and cared for, here I get a daily touch of love as from a loving father and mother. And I enjoy sisters and My dears bothers and sisters, as you see here, we're changing lives.
