LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMS

One of the main wings of this ministry to Romania is to raise up new leaders and offer further training to those leaders and pastors who just began in the ministry. The truth is, most pastors in Romania don't have a basic Bible knowledge. They study a little and try to apply that knowledge. Many times they learn from their own mistakes and misfires. Here I'll have at least a dozen living testimonies of how these new trained leaders and pastors, many saved only a few years are trained up by CCFR. They are successfully pastoring growing churches. Not only that but these new churches reach out to the poor and destitute, to the dying and the hopeless orphans. They are the first responders, giving emergency service to rescue the dying and the drowning body and souls. I would like to mention here that the above testimonies of the needy



kids like Daniel and Adriana were found out and brought to the camps by these new pastors. These four men are reaching out unto the most remote and neglected parts of the towns and villages where the knowledge about Christ's salvation just crept in.

After the summer camps we'll start with discipleship Bible schools, pastoral seminars and conferences. We'll be finding, reaching and raising new leaders for the Lord's continuing ministry on the earth. Please pray for the national pastor's conference between June 26th to the 28th. Around 200 pastors and leaders will be present. We expect a renewal leadership miracle that brings forth a church revival to reach out the lost souls of Romania.

Thanks for your prayers and support to raise Gospel leaders in Romania. I'm expecting some new friendly churches, which never supported us before, to join us on regular or special projects.

I'm also expecting new individuals to jump in with their

giving hearts. May God open your hearts for these East Europe people, living on the border of west Asia, in the Valachia, Oltenia region.

ORSOVA CHURCH PLANTING

AND NEW BUILDING

The city of Orsova is a strategic regional city that is on the border of south Oltenia right on the Romanian and Serbian border. Orsova is in the Banat region in the west that splits Romania and Serbia and in the south-west, a middle ground between Transylvania and Oltenia.

It's a mix culture between the two countries, and between the regions, as well the population is a mix of different nations and various groups of people.

The city didn't have any evangelical church, only Orthodox and Catholic. Most of the population living here don't have a knowledge about the Gospel of salvation.



And those who are calling themselves Christians didn't read the Bible, understand it or know the life facts of it, and don't attend a church. In the church is a lot of superstition, mostly they worship and pray to dead saints, and they don't worship Christ Himself directly.



Pastor Ludovic Veres is from Hungarian, Slovakian decent. He lived in the Central part of Romania but because of his job many years ago moved to Orsova city. By missionaries endeavors there, he got saved, and took our discipleship and leadership classes. Today he a pastor with a great vision given from the Lord, to reach out with the Gospel of salvation to each dweller of the city. Now the church numbers about fifty active members, besides children. The church was too small to hold the overflow of attenders, so we together prayed and by a miracle of God, got a former large mansion that was being built. The Lord moved the heart of the owner to sell it to this church at a lower price as he felt God will bless him in other ways.

We spent already about \$20,000 to make the property usable, just to get the church in. First step is, we need a roof over this church as the flat sealed roof already started leaking. We are praying to get the real high peaked roof with additional room under it, rooms that are highly needed for the children ministry. The cost to make it possible is about \$15.000

Please pray with us, for this urgent need. This is the best outreach church under Bishop Milo Novacovici for the area. It is operated following closely the church of Motru. Orsova city is much large than Motru and strategically located so the future perspective is greater. From this corner of Romania, we can reach out to the whole south of Romania and to the south of Banat-Transylvania that is also as spiritually dry as the Oltenia region. There is a great possibilities to reach over to Serbia and Bulgaria.

Please continue to keep us in prayer, it is just early June, and in a couple of days will be in the ministry, traveling all over Romania.

Please pray for the leadership training programs we'll be starting right away, and pray for the main leadership seminar of June 26th throu the 28th. Bishop Richard Heard who is the main speaker, pray the Lord may use him mightily. And for our leadership basic team in Romania.

Pray for the summer camps, that many will be rescued and saved and turned to a new life in Christ.

Pray for the building to be finished at Orsova church and that its church outreaches that the Lord may pour on them His Kingdom favors.

Praise the Lord for the Church of Motru, last time I presented the last straw brick to finish it, so it can be used and the church to move in for good. Pastor Mark Duke from Brentwood, CA, just sent \$10.000 to finish the church.

Myself, I consider each piece of what is being accomplished in Romania a true miracle from God, not because of me, nor of our good presentations to you, but just the mercy and the favor of God as the acting major player who is with us and you are included.

Please pray for all of these, and if the Lord moves in your heart send a Kingdom brick to Romania!
