I'm just back from Romania, we've had a very unique Spring time of ministry that is made special because of the uniqueness of a new stage of the Lord's presence.

It's been like a new level of spirituality followed immedi-

ately by the harvest of the rippened fruit that came into being so I could see and touch it. There were pastors, leaders or people whom the Lord made an everlasting impact in their hearts and lives. This is like a spontaneous clear sight to see at one time all the efforts and hard work done over the many years of ministry to the hearts and needs of these precious church leaders the Lord loves so much.

Here, I just shortly want to bring you a report, mainly of the most important ministry events that took place, without having enough space and time to name so many short-range outreaches accomplished. But here and there on the next coming letters I'll bring up some of the stories we have been touched collectively.

LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS ARE BRING FORTH FRUIT

First national leadership conference of this year took place to Baile Felix, North-west of Romania with Dr Morris Sheats and Pastor Jackie White from Lubbock, TX as our guest speakers.



National Leadership Conference

It was a great Bible seminar with over one hundred leaders who came from all over Romania. The presence of God covered the place as pastors and ministry leaders changed their lives forever. It uplifted their vision of how to reach Romania for Christ, and the way the church of Christ should function; not as an institution of men but as a living entity full of life that offers the living bread and water and bring fullness of life for the thirsty souls.



The second national leaders conference took place at Baile Olanesti that is south-east Romania with Dr Dale Yerton from Kansas and Pastor Kelly Break from Alaska.

The powerful deep-spiritual principles blended with practical life teaching made this gathering of leaders a set apart event. We have witnessed a true unity in the body of Christ. Leaders coming from different backgrounds took hands to stand together. I was amazed to see the audience of leaders get a spiri-



tual eye to see. The speakers were under a heavy special anointing. The conference speakers affirming this class of leaders were true disciples on a higher level of understanding and receiving, it is good to throw this kind of unity, spirit ball one to the other.

Both of these two Bible conferences were highly considered by our leaders in Romania as a straight message from God directed to them. In fact most of them I spoke with told me, the message of God was directed personally to me, because it revealed the actual problems and needs, and answered to my unanswered questions. And there was so much new Word revelation of where Romania is today and what the pastors and the church must do to reach it for Him.

We're expecting church revivals from all the corners of Romania but mostly from the south where since a couple of years, God has turned



something little into something greater. This is the right place where still millions have never heard the message of salvation, and we need a miracle revival to turn into a move of salvation for their lost souls.

Gypsy community Revival

Toflea is a Gypsy town in the east of Romania. A few years ago revival started there. This one Gypsy church by now numbers around 3000 believers, and because of their treading jobs, they have spread over six major cities of Romania. Each of the new young church planted has more than one hundred believers. In the springtime, I ministered in two of these Gypsy churches, spending time with them, and with each leader.

> In our Bible conferences we pick them as a priority group of leaders, usually about 20 seats are reserved for them. I start to consider that a wide revival may come to Romania kindled by the Gypsy believers who are becoming very passionate for the Lord Jesus as many of them are delivered from a host of evils and witchcraft practices. This witness was such that everyone was convinced of the true change. So, lately I'm more and more involved within the Gypsy outreaches, and encourage their leaders to become multi race congregations and reach to Romanians and other groups of people as well.

Smaller, person-to-person seminars

Between the large conferences we hold smaller regional and local leadership Bible seminars. This is a good thing as I can spend quality time with each one of them, and as we teach, I see them face to face and I'm joined with the spark in their eye.

These we may call discipleship Bible Schools, it's a place where we pick up new disciples and then continue to invest on personal bases with each one of them. I do love very much these smaller, personto-person seminars because usually here we come with the final line product to finish the work the Lord had given us to do, namely here they are sent out to do the work of the ministry.

I present here a seminar with our guest speakers, Senior Pastor Philip Hoss and his Assistant Pastor Dan McGee from Temecula, CA. This was their first time with us in Romania, but their support has backed us for a couple of years. I'm expecting other pastors, like them, to come and help Romania. More and more worldwide ministers see Romania as the center of east revival and even invading the west, this comes both by sensitive observation and backed by the prophetic word.

This early local Bible seminar was a great start to open the doors for what was to come where we had seen the hand of God over the year leadership outreaches and what it is yet to come. It was a kind of revealed introduction of what would follow up after. God is the greatest architect. He knows beforehand everything and we need just to be sensitive, understand and believe the works of God in us. This teaching done by Pastor McGee was sweet encouragement of a blueprint map, to repent and get the righteousness of God in us and then expect Him to do like in heaven here on the earth. Pastors and churches are also encouraged by the visiting pastors, just one sermon in the church may give them a jump that otherwise could not be accomplished over the months or even years.

I see this when I preach or teach shortly in a church led by one of my spiritual son in the Lord, and I feel he is doing exceedingly better than I do, but at the end people are stopping to pray and talk to me confessing how the Lord spoke to them, and changed their lives forever, asking me to stay longer with them.

WHAT OUR VISIONARY LEADERS ARE DOING IN THE FIELD

The Word says, that without knowledge and vision, the people perish. Hosea 4: 6.

This is the same for a ministry leader and a church if they don't have a focus of where to go and what to do, then, at their very best, simply become professional religious leaders who are speaking and preaching but doing nothing more.

Here we have a local overseer Senior Pastor Relu Paraluta who was mostly present at all of our national conferences, and was teaching local seminars organized by him in his regional area of ministry. He is very much a part of everything we do in Romania, not



only in the teaching programs but as well in our practical visionary outreaches. Our ministry motto is "What you've learned today practice it right away". He does it, like so many others in whom we invested heavily, the Lord is sending us to use wisely the precious time and the money we have. Just about a couple of weeks ago, he asked me to give him a special personal time as he needed personal godly counseling, so while traveling from Bucharest to Timisoara I spent several hours, as he told his life of ministry, and all present struggles and confrontations he is facing. It was a truly blessed and sweet time as the Spirit wisdom and the Lord's favor was very much present, so he came out like a new fresh man full of passion and love for the Lord and the people he serves and to continuing to stay ready for any good work God assigned for Him to do.

While with him, I asked him if he has in his regional leadership area a real poor family whose home may be ruined of bad roof leaks or it may be in an emergency need of fixing a home to keep the family safe from the rain, cold or hot weather.

I told him that I received a special donation from a saint sister from the states who felt to help a family with that kind of need. I told him, myself, I felt strongly that in this area is someone with that kind of need. Immediately, I saw tears in his eyes, he started to tell me that just last night of a precious mom, a young widow whose husband died about five years ago, and she has five children within the range between seven to sixteen years old. She is from a neighboring town, named Filiasi, pastor told me, she called me last night excusing herself and hardly could tell me that the roof of their old house they live in, because of heavy raining was badly damaged and water leaks broke inside home, the ceiling is also ruined and now the water gets in bedroom and kitchen, and pieces of ceiling falling over them.

He promised her that rescue help was on the way, because God is able to help the widow and the poor. However, he knew and sadly told his wife, I don't know where the money will come from, but let's pray to the Lord now, we'll need to help her, even if we may need to sell something from our own home. He tells me that when her husband died after a quick cancer. Pastor Paraluta and his wife made a promise before God and to her that they will do their very best to help her with whatever the needs may be and never drop her from their helping list. But this came in a very harsh time, lacking money in the family, and their poor small newplanted churches around them were also drained of money resources as lately they had so many needs. And now it is so hard to ask people to give more offerings, as they knew these people are lacking themselves money. Instead they considered to sell something from their own home, like a piece of furniture, their chicken and pig or whatever and help this lady out from the turmoil. However, God to whom all of our needs are known before hand intervened. and \$700 were received right away, and \$100 from my family budget filled up the pastor thank who lacked that money to drive his car to reach the needs of other people around them. For Pastor Relu this was a big miracle of immediate answer to prayer that came just right on the spot, in fact it was just on the second day after the her call.

Now after an experienced builder estimated the reparing, said the whole roof should be replaced, to make sure it will not break again and ruin the whole home, but for now with that fund they fixed up the ceiling and patched up the roof, but with another \$1400 they may have a new roof on, so please pray that the rest of the money may come any way the Lord may chose it.

This I tell you one of the small but many miraculous stories are taken place in the ministry, but we praise God, as He is the architect of all of it, we truly need to trust Him, as the needs and projects are above our own control or resources.

Now you had seen one of the pastor work for whom we offer our time to train and cast vision to reach both the poor and the rich for Christ, it is not only about teaching but coaching and trained to play and running their own course that is being done right on the ground. We're not here in the business to make big heads but developing big hearts for Christ and His people as real faith is coming from the heart not from the head, and then the mind is transformed too.

So, let's stand for the work God is given us to do and to finish and not give up by the accounts and logics of our minds!
