There for the first time she received three meals a day and other snacks, like fruit and chocolate. She became the happiest girl in the world, being introduced to a piece of life she never experienced before. When the camp was over she asked us if we could keep her longer for the next camp and confessed, I can't believe, how happy I feel here. Is that because Jesus love had reached my heart? We wanted to take her back to this years summer camp, along with many other precious children. Isn't that good that the Lord enabled us to bring Jesus back on the earth?
