The orthodox priest has threatened her family that they will be cursed and expelled out from the community.

THE PREVENTION AND RESCUE CENTER

The Prevention and Rescue Center in Motru, Oltenia region, is making a great difference in the lives of many poor families whose teenagers are being rescued and saved from a life of sex slavery. To some this means a certain sentence to death, for when these exploiters finish with the girls instead of letting them go free they are killed in order to cover up their crime.

Here is an article that was posted in the Agerpres Daily News:

Two Romanian girls were sold for 10.000 euro in Italy. A human traffickers group of Romanian and Albanian citizens traded two girls from the south of Romania for 10.000 euro. The girls were 20 year old and were taken to Italy for waitress jobs, but ended up in an underground prostitution center in Alessandria, Italy. They were beaten, went hungry for days and forced into prostitution.

They were saved when one of the girls told her story to a client, though that could have proven dangerous. They might have been killed as the traffickers warned and threaten the girls. The strong need to get out and be free compelled her to risk her life. The man reported it to the police.
