By faith we continue the construction of the church building at Motru, Oltenia. With our CCFR ministry group, we are looking for true spiritual revival in our town. We're continually praying to God for this. The church building will include one large hall for 300 seats. This building will be used as a sanctuary for our church people, and multifunctional for different leadership conferences, Bible Training programs, kindergarten class, and feeding the children from our prevention program. We hope to build the next building, the Safe and Rescue Unit, as our next phase.

The next step to take is to build the walls, we have the brick, but we need to finish the roof. We need about \$10,000 to buy the needed materials. By faith we look to finish this building, hopefully by October. We want to get inside before the weather turns cold. Please pray and if the Lord speaks to you, come and join and we will build together! We don't have the money or any list of sponsors to continue with the next building phases, and our congregation is very new in the Lord. Jobs are scarce here and the few available, are very low paid jobs. This location is a deep poverty region of Romania. We need your help.

Reaching the public market place

Last week we were in the public market of Stejaru town. Occasionally, we go in the market to reach the towns and villages where we're planting churches. These places are: Motru city, Brosteni town, Stejaru town and Bacles village. Pray for us to have God's favor and open hearts to bring the good news to these poor people.



While in Stejarul village we had a wonderful time, a few of our churches were involved, interacted with people, and hundreds of people were ministered the Gospel to them. The kids and parents were having fun with us, painting their faces. We had different games for them and made them laugh while they were told the

story of Jesus. We then showed them the movie, **The Passion of Christ.** It was a great time and many received Jesus, the source of life, hope and joy.

Caring For Poor kids in Need

Our focus is to work with children in educational programs, food, clothes and sharing His love with them. These kids are poor and hurting, some living on the streets. We're compelled to take them to different rented places or outside in the open air, serving meals and assisting them with education and protection. These precious children and youth are craving for us to come and just be with them. This is a ray of hope to them, taking care of them and sharing the love of Jesus with them. The town's people where we minister these acts of love, know their children are at risk. They appreciate our work for their teenagers and children.







I onut, is a boy, age eight. He is from an alcoholic family with many other siblings who gets no love or care. About two years ago, because of being

not supervised he was run over by a car, receiving a head injury, and broken limbs and hands. The surgeons put a rod in him to help his bones. After six months he had the rod taken out, but his parents after the surgery didn't supervise him. He developed post surgery complications to his leg. This is how we're ministering to these children, and in different needs in this area. We took him to the main hospital that is about three hours away from our smaller city of Motru. We cared for him and, as a result, his medical problem was positively solved, otherwise he would be handicapped, the rest of his life. Praise the Lord, his precious life was rescued and now he is enjoying a normal child's life.
