In the Gypsy community there is a great respect for the paranormal, and their religion is based in witchcraft, they worship it and some draw their income from it. Consequently this creates a hard wall of opposition from their witch doctors and the devil, but also from people being afraid to change their lives from evils of cheating, lying and stealing to a holy righteous life. I preached several times there and I know of what I'm speaking. It was a proving wonderful thing that we have brother Nicu, a Gypsy saved by the Lord, who was intensively trained in Christ, and then became a pastor. He talks in their own language, convincing them that what Jesus offers is superior to what Satan offered him in the past as he lived all of these sins we named above. Thanks again to Pastor Huie who invested not only in the leadership training but also helped to buy the home building for the church.

Desa New Plant and the Grace Church Building

The Desa church had fully completed the church building! The roof and all the insides were nicely and well done. Pastor Gigel Ignat and the church is thanking you very much for helping them with the roof and other materials.

This is a miracle church building as it brought not only the new church members together while building, but as well the whole village. Many unsaved villagers came together to build up something for their own community and in the process these unsaved but dedicated people got saved, and others who witnessed it but could not participate came up asking for prayer and water baptism. This wonderful gorgeous building in the village of Desa was built by love. The location is right on the crossroads downtown village. Here, where several years ago there were no believers at all, now meet about 150 members. This village is in a poverty agricultural region of Romania, it stands just across the Bulgarian border, and they are far away from big towns and cities to hold up any well paid city jobs, but people are surviving on what they can produce out of their own gardens and small pieces of farming land. If they wouldn't have received outside financial assistance, it would have been really hard to get done this great thing on their own. They gave their own time, working hard, proudly building their own family fellowship church, and gave in all the little money they had, some saved over many years. They all sent you their true love and thanks, and are praying to see you if it is not possible here, then in heaven for sure they will meet with you. Let's Build Together!

My Name is Florina Angel, I'm from a family of nine siblings, (5 boys and 4 girls)

I'm an orphan of father who over two years ago died of brain cancer. We're living with our dear mama in a small shabby home, our income is very small, it is just a social state assistance. This assistance supports us for less than two weeks, and the other two weeks we get by with prayer and faith that we may find a job here and there.

I was a very studious girl in the family. I loved reading, so I borrowed books, and acquired some for myself. I made high grades while in the local school, in fact I was the first honored, School University student of my class. I fought to attend a Timisoara college, and because of my high

school grades and references I was quickly accepted at the Medical School.

However, there was a big problem with my room and board, the rent was too high in the city. With two friends we rented a downgraded apartment, but still when we added all the utility expenses the cost was high, and my budget was short month by month. I was getting behind with the bills. My mother tried to find more work in the village, to assist me, I did the same in Timisoara, but met little success.

At the summer break I knew that I couldn't continue building debt for another year. My only hope was God, I knew, if He hears my prayers He could help me with it so I prayed hard on a daily basis. But God seemed not to answer my prayers, it was just a week before starting the second year, while I was convulsing in my doubts, a distant

friend came by and told me about the ministry of the Life Center, and then she found me a phone number to call. I prayed, and then called. At the other end was Costel Prisacaru, the Life Center director, he took time to look around at all the rooms to find a niche for me. Finally he said, I'm very sorry, you came too late by now all the rooms are fully occupied.

But while talking to me, he encouraged me to continue to pray, who knows how the Lord does miracles, maybe a student will be ready to go, graduate and live independently. And if God's will is for you to be here it will. PTL! Just a day before I started classes at medical university while wondering where I'll live, I received a call from brother Costel who happily told me, just today we got a vacant place, a fourth year student gave up his place to move and pay rent with a family he got to know while here with us. And remember, this is because you did pray, you know how to beseech our Father.

I thanked the Lord who had mercy on me, as I know it was not because of me being worthy but because the love and the favor of God over me. To be here at the Life Center is the best thing that has happened to me. It is a perfect blessing from God. Here not only is a good place to stay and eat, but it is a Bible school and missionary center as well. Here we're building up a godly character, and it is creating so many opportunities to serve and minister to other needy people.

We thank the Lord for Life Outreach International, James and Betty Robinson for still supporting us down here, and equally to Pastor John Dolinschi who had a vision from God together with LOI to build this marvelous building in this great universities city of Timisoara. And to other supporters and people who are coming around here and making a long standing with us. And also to brother and father

Costel, and the Life center Staff who we trust like our own family. May the Lord reward you for what you have done for us here at the Life Center family.

Ministry to the Homeless, and the Summer Camps projects

Life Center continues to minister life to the street people, besides heralding the hope of Jesus, we're blessing them with a hot meal or sometime snacks. Our students shared with them their own past lives of living in poverty and addiction.
