The Life Center is a mission outreach going wild for Christ. They go wherever the most need may be. They go to places where the small church plants are beginning. These fresh believers are expecting a revival time when our students visit them. Giving much encouragement in the Lord, our staff and students offer growth steps for each church we minister to.

Early this Spring we went to Dumbrava, Bihor county. The Life Center director Constantin Prisacaru and the students ministered to the abandoned old couples and single elders, most of them have no biological

family left. They are forgotten by the whole world. We are here to rescue and save their souls for life here and eternity to come. The associate ministry helps to buy skid properties and broken homes, then builds decent little apartments for these poor people. The Life Center involves other local churches standing together behind this nursing home to save and rescue and mend the broken lives.

While there we dedicate special time to each precious gentlemen and lady as some are in very great need to receive Christ and counseling. We pray with each one of them to make peace with God, and pray for their whole wellbeing.

My name is Vanessa Ibis, I'm an orphan of both parents, I didn't have the chance to see my parents or to have siblings but was raised in a lonely orphanage where I didn't understand the real love of a true family. I always craved for a family kind of love. I always felt God the creator of my life is my real Father, so I started to talk more often to Him. Whenever I was afraid and in pain, I prayed and then felt really good, though I wasn't sure He really listened or communicate with me. Deep inside I felt good and safe to have that talk with someone I didn't see. The Lord helped me to get up and finish high school with rather higher grades than I was expecting myself to make. I felt that I should go to a college and somehow be more prepared for real life.

I loved books and reading so I wanted to get into the faculty of literature and letters, a great college of Timisoara, but Timisoara was not an easy and cheap place to live. All the while I conversed with God. Suddenly, I found out from someone about the Life Center home to assist little poor people like me, so with fear in my heart I applied. Immediately after they opened their hearts wide to receive me in, securing a room and a bed for me.

I really felt that my father God gave me this immediate favor with them to show His compassion to me, a lonely poor girl like I was. More good news was that I was admitted to the college I wished to be part of.

Here at the Life Center I entered in to my true family, I felt all of these young people are my sisters and brothers. The leaders were showing the love I imagined parents had for their own kids so at last I felt I'm somewhere where I'm safe and can call home.

Another blessing is here we have so much, plenty of food, I never go hungry like times in the past, I stay in the best clean dorm with another girl that I adopted to be my sister. Thanks to God as I found in the Bible if we're forgotten and abandoned by parents, the Lord will never leave or forsake us! And here I found out more about my true Father and my own identity, and the firm faith in Christ Jesus our Savior. Praise the Lord for I came to understand that I was not the one who was chasing God, but all the time God was chasing after me. I'm sure that He will do it in all the days of my life for

While the church planting ministry is working out good, the feeding program for the hungry is moving forward here in the Wallachian Oltenia region. Many people survive living in poverty are helped by the children feeding programs we had in the village of Secu, Garbovat, Motru, Valea lui Patru, and others. Here in Secu village about 50 kids were reached and fed at different times. Some were provided clothes and shoes and

Now two vans will do the Romania job, my own transporter van I drove, from this moment will be in the full use for children and feeding programs in southern Romania. And the new purchased used van will mostly be used for transporting people as ministry teams, children, youth and often loaded with grocery from the larger city's food stores with supplies for the

special love treats they may never get otherwise. That is the way King Jesus would have done, and anyway, He is providing today as He did in the past, feeding the big crowds! Most of these kids live in very poor families, others with disabilities are not able to work. And others are raised in the foster homes with less love, and even more may be orphan of one or both parents and are raised by other distant family members.

It is always good when we have a dear family like **David with Becky** who provided not only a light meal but a great delicious meal for each child who was with us in prayer, singing, games and playing on the church ground with them. Many shown desire to follow Jesus and were nicely behaved!

We do really hope we'll have other of our brothers from America coming to see and help the children of Romania, and others just to send money to buy food, the meals and clothing for them.

Thanks God for a new Volkswagen van purchased.
