My name is David Palincas, I am from a 12 children family. I am in my first year at the West University of Timisoara. I was raised in a family that lived under the poverty level, hardly meeting our daily meals and needs. My parents are of retirement age struggling with bad health issues. Certainly, it was out of the picture to think my parents could support me at the University. Even, if I got a full time job I would not be able meet the expenses. Timisoara has very high rent, the school fees and taxes, eating and buying shoes and clothing, all put together was way too much for me. I truly considered giving up further education, but rather find another low paid job to support myself through life. But as I was still praying to God about my tough situation, I had a thought. Maybe there is a way out that I don't know about. Why should I worry all the time about the lack of

money. I was created to love books and engineering studies, isn't that enough for me. Then I got on the internet, and applied to Timisoara West University, just to see if they will accept me or not. To my complete amazement I received the admission letter that invited me to start classes on the school year of 2016-2017. Next, I took a little money, books and some papers and boarded the train to Timisoara, I thought it's better to check personally about it. While I was exploring Timisoara I found out about the Life Center home, and picked up the address and drop in there. On the second day I was accepted as a Life Center student, and all my living expenses paid off.

This was the biggest day of my life, celebrating of how good our God is. I called my parents and brothers to celebrate together with me.

There is no other way I could make it here in this large and beautiful city of Timisoara unless Life Center existed to support such poor kids like me. Here the unsaved will be saved, and all of us together are getting closer to God as we take all these godly steps implemented by the Life Center. It looks like all of us are becoming ministers to serve for the rest of our lives faithfully to the Lord and others.

Thank you to all of you who are supporting us the poor but the bold daring young people who are trying to make good in this life, and for sure, we'll be succeeding!

PTL! The Country Clinic Building project is being Purchased.

We are actually in the process of fixing and renovating. Shortly the clinic will be fully operated by Christian doctor Denisa Feca. Looking back in time this little town, Poiana Mare of about 10.000 people, didn't have any evangelical church nor believers. Now we have a small church of about 50 believers. It is a great start. There was just a part time available doctor, operating from a private home, and today like out from nowhere a public clinic is established. Out from the Kingdom of God this heavenly embassy was raised up to assist people in their medical needs!

Thanks to Pastor Doreen Mast of Tri Lakes Community church, Indiana, they paid a good portion so the building was cleared and available!



The project is going forth however, still needed is \$2500 more to make it function like a real clinic.

Moldoveni Church progress. This church was featured in a couple of CCFR recent news letters. We were working to complete the building. Now, it looks really great and is a very welcoming home sweet home. Timing for the harvest is now for more souls are coming and decided to stay.

One thing is still to be done, it lacks the heating system to heat up the sanctuary. If we get this done, then the inviting will be more likely to come in and

get some warmth from the cruel weather, while the Holy Spirit fire will bring their souls unto God.

\$2700 will be needed for a complete heating system, hopefully we will get this done by His grace!

The Christmas Shoe Project is marching on, if you have a heart to shoe up the little children bare cold feet, please hurry up and send your donation. In a little while the funds will be wired to our Romania ministry office so our leaders can start making good shoe purchasing deals with the shoe factory and large shoe stores.

I am on the road for the Leaders Bible Seminars in the far South by Serbian, Bulgaria borders to the East of the Black Sea, at Mamaia resort. We'll have our last national leaders conference of this year. I drove for about 10 hours to get here. Thanks for your prayers on the training and raising up new leaders. We see God has quicken our leadership programs and pastors are caught up in the love of the Lord. And thanks to Pastor Ed Huie and Terry Scott who are our speakers for the actual Bible conference.

As you read this letter just thank the Lord for what already He had done. We know great things are going to happen.
