The end of October we held our *National Leadership Conference-Seminar*. About 170 pastors came from all over the corners of Romania to the top of the mountains at Brasov Meadow recreational area. Our speaker was Bishop Richard Heard, pastor of Christian Tabernacle Church of Houston, a real humble man of God

carrying a profound powerful anointing and teaching gift. The conference topic was "Elevating the King and His Kingdom" It is hard to describe in words this special gathering. From the beginning to the end, everybody felt we were under a permanent shadow of God's power. It was like we were locked in the X-ray room of light and love with no visible door to get out until your doctor says, it is finished, you can go. This heavenly package came with forgiveness, deliverance, restoration and freedom, family integration, healing of the soul and of the body.

I was sent to preach the Gospel to the poor and broken hearted!

People were changed in their hearts and minds and ready to step out in the Kingdom of God's provision.



I heard pastors speaking out great testimonies of how they were touched by God, and I overheard them say to one another, this is the greatest presence of God meeting I have ever been in, and I want my people to have this. How I can deliver in preaching the same life ingredient to them.

I'm sorry I hadn't much time to gather testimonials, I had to leave right away, but the leaders lined up to shake our hands, showing us

their appreciations. Here in Romania pastors are in great need of Bible training so they can minister day by day. Some have teaching but many are very young children of God. I call these pastors - dedicated passionate missionaries working and living in hard and primitive life conditions. They are fulfilling what Jesus said about His own ministry; I was sent to preach the Gospel to the poor and broken hearted!

Pastor Costel Gramada, the main organizer of this conference, told me: Pastor John, though I was busy with the daily details of the conference, I received the deep waters message of Bishop Heard. The spiritual atmosphere in the room lifted me to a higher dimension relationship with my Father God. I feel this impacted my life and ministry and I'm very sure no longer will I be the same. And regarding the CCFR Leadership Fellowship network, of which you're the founder father, many leaders in Romania are radically changing the way they minister to others.

Here is another pastor and close friend, Pastor Relu Paraluta, who with his team planted dozens of churches and is the Bishop leader of the central south, Oltenia region. Pastor Reul writes. My spiritual dear father John, I do still feel so happy and blessed because of the last conference. I am in a constant joy of the Lord. Progress report of Secu church building

Last spring we started building the Secu church building. An old saints family from the state of Washington donated several thousands dollars, it was a miraculous move as the Lord spoke to their heart to give toward this church building. This happened because the children who attending the church started to pray fervently that the



Lord would helps with money. The church owned land and wanted to build a church building that they could call their sweet home. Since the first evangelism reached the Secu village, each year these kids and teenagers were blessed with Christmas shoes, clothing and meals. Their hearts of faith the Lord heard and came to their rescue by the Clark's family project.

Much was done before the money ran out and now they have halted work as their faith goes out once again, looking for God's provision. (Will God call you to answer their prayers?)

When Pastor Florin, who is from Pastor Milo's Oltenia team, preached for the first time, there were no believers at all, in fact they knew almost nothing about Jesus the Savior. Now some of these kids are teenagers and are deeply rooted in their faith while practicing it with boldness. Please join with us and these kids to lay a roof on the building. We are ready to begin construction at any time to do the job regardless of the cold or warm season, we just need the financial cover to start.

Circeni Gypsy Church project and needs

This Gypsy community consist of 2000 people. This large village settlement is very remote. It is on top of steep and rough hills in the likeness of the native Indians of America. It is truly a wilderness area. Maybe the first group who settled here looked to find relief and quietness out from the discrimination of the world around them. The land in not farm land, even a small garden is a challenge here. The Gypsies survive by raising chicken, goats, sheep and donkeys. In the dry summers, water is scarce and must be carried from a mile down the valley. They live here and are too poor to move anywhere else. However, people are happy for they receive the living water from God. They joke, saying, hey we may not need the potable water if we have the healing living water springing in our midst. The Lord heals them of many life killing diseases.

God really moved on this community and many people were saved and are being saved day by day. The church moved from house to house, from a smaller building to a large one but the place again became too small. The church grew to 150 members. They began building believing a promise from a western church that they would be assisted, but this promise didn't come true. The roof was placed over the new enlarged building but the ceiling is still lacking. At this time the church people cannot meet in the building. They split in groups here and there in different homes. Some of the homes are too small to get all the church members in, so some people are left out of the worship meeting.

The need is for about \$1500 to have the ceiling and the insulation protection so they can heat the sanctuary and move into the church to worship there. We pray God will send someone to sponsor this eternal worthy life project and let the unsaved come in the house of God and get saved.

Miracle of God's Provision works for the faithful poor families of Circeni

By our dear Pastor Relu Paraluta, Pastor Milo Novacovici and others, we always try to help the very poor precious families from Circeni. The same we do with other broken towns and villages in Romania.

Viorel and Mihaela Moda tells us their story. They needed money to have surgery for one of their little children. God sent the money without telling others their emergency need, they were needing money to travel to Bucharest and pay a special hospital and specialist doctor to perform a rare surgery and by God's grace it was done as requested and the boy lives stronger and healthier.

Bebe and Carmen Anghel shared with us that they didn't have any food to lay on the table for the their 10 little kids. They will have to go hungry. But that evening they gathered their kids and started to pray and thank God that the food will be there for the next morning. Sure enough, the next morning lots more food, some clothing and a washing machine knocked at their door. This was much more than they asked for, but God knew they need it all.

I can go further and tell story after story but the writing space permits me not to do it. I conclude this newsletter to you in a heartfelt prayer! As I told you we have been in Romania since May. Our personal and ministry support is very low at this time. I didn't get the time while in Romania to communicate back to you. I was working, and working to preach and reaching the poor for Christ. Now we're lacking, our personal support is very low. I am believing that together we can do a job of prayer, practicing faith to have the increase both personally and in the ministry.
