With about \$500 we help these pastors for a full week to feed these kids a meal a day, teach them the Bible and gives them a playtime. Some of them will decide to stay in the Kingdom forever.

Pastor said this blessed 70 to 100 kids a day, and at the end we distributed to each school pulpit a couple of notebooks and pens.

I was in a couple of such meetings and what a blessing to be among these kids, whatever difficult problems you may be in have the joy of the Lord just overwhelms you!

The American team started this summer with one special chapel service for the fall new year semester. Some became preachers, singers and church leaders, also they are doctors, assistant doctors, a variety of engineers, architects, teachers and professors or qualified personnel and workers. The Life Center outreach ministry does not get any vacation, it reaches out to others in summer or winter, when students are in school or out of school, if our students are out, we rely on our staff and former graduates to do the work of the ministry. The Center is a Life job training program to help the orphan, the destitute and the poor child to achieve and make good in life, but Life Center is also a practical Bible school and missionary training center.

Many of our students marry, they turn to us to perform their marriage ceremonies, and to represent them as a parental home. Please pray for the Life Center newly enrolled students who just started a life with us.



Here I just picked up an application from the big enrollment pile. This is like so many other applications. Liliana Mihad applied and was received in our LC family, like most of them she is from the South part of Oltenia, the most poor region of Romania. Here is what she wrote for us: My family is struggling to live day by day, not having a constant income from my good father. He takes good care of my mom who has a chronic neurotically disease. She is mostly bed ridden or in the hospital room. My father takes care of my mom and my little five year old brother. The city hall sends us a small amount that pays a little of our monthly expenses, and mostly is used for my mom's medicine. Father, on occasion tries to work here and there for a few hours a day to make a little extra money in order that we may survive.



In school I made higher grades, achieving the honors. I love to study and learn new things and I pick up fast the information.

If you would accept me to Timisoara Life Center, besides going to college, I would look for a job to help my family who relied on my assistance in work and money.

Now this describes the general need in Romania and the struggle that comes with it, either we're on the church planting field or here in the big city of Timisoara our heart is crushed by the pain and compassion for these kind of people we work daily with.
