The young widow Ilona Raduceanu and her five kids were truly blessed with not only a new roof but with a complete house repaired and remolded. If you look back to our June letter, I told the story of this widow and about the rain leaking in her shabby home. However, instead of a \$800 roof repair or about \$2000 for a new roof we ended up receiving over \$5000 for a complete home renewal and made this home worth living in. In June we made sure to temporary patched the roof to stop the water and damages inside the home.

The first part of summer we had lots of rain in Romania, in fact most of the summer was stormy with several areas flooding in the south. We had to delay the roof work, but while we waited we prayed to get more money to do a whole remolding job that the house badly needed.

Presently the home has a new roof, the walls have been repaired with plaster and paint. The flooring has been repaired also. If you take a look at the June letter, you hardly recognize the old house besides the renewed one. Here in the picture the roof still not all finished, and even at this time some work is still remaining to be done.

To accomplish the work, I gave

some money from my own family budget, and our student daughters participated generously and sent money too. We received more funds from CCFR donations for the roof, from a couple of generous people from America, thanks you, for heartily given to this rescue service!

We all love to give up ourselves on these sort of projects where the real need is, and this uplifts our spirits, and feel blessed afterwards.
