While leading the volunteer workers he builds along with them. He takes the hardest jobs, and in the process has learned to be more of a professional builder. Pastor's hands are on the work as his mouth talks about God's love. God makes miracles for his household and for all the people who love Him. A few unsaved men and women were evangelized and were prayed for, right there on the job site while they were taken the time to volunteer alongside with the new believers.

Now they are in the process of installing the heating system for the building, and the church still needs the final fund for to finish. He continues to believe God who will finish what He started.

However, what I would present this time to you is the pastor family need of a monthly support. Since a long time there is no monthly support and usually they do not have other monthly income. They survive with a small garden and several chickens, however, they make good use of what they have, and the Lord provides here and there.

About \$300 a month will be a great reliable blessing for this wonderful family who is faithful to our Lord. Please

consider it as a divine circle of blessing going from one to the other. Starting with you and Florin's support that is going to other people around them. They in turn will be saved and blessed. This blessing comes back to you.

Orsova City Church is Growing and Reaching the City

The church is right on the Danube River, Serbia is just across the river. This first evangelical church planted is making a life difference in the city, it stands tall and spreads around as a tree of life. Now almost all the town people know there is a church that makes a life difference in their city.

This is the first city to the west of Wallachia border with Transylvania, but there was no church until this church made a first step into the town. The communist dictator Ceausescu kept the city atheistic.

Pastor Ludovic Laiko makes his family income as a border policeman, patrolling up and down the Danube River. His compassionate spiritual binoculars beholds on the people who are belonging to the Kingdom of God territory. Ludovic ministers and serves more outside the church building than inside. People get to know him from his job more than his preaching from the church building.

However, this church building is not fully operating yet. It is needing expansion and some finishing.

The most current problem the church has is a leaking roof. It was a temporary flat roof that has run it's life. Water damage is ruining the inside walls, and the molding odor is not comfortable or healthy for the people inside. Please pray that the church may get the fund. The roof will costs about \$10,000.
