After this one conference, we are no longer be the same, but expecting a rival and not just a few pastors and churches but the whole of Romania.





In these last few months, many of our Life Center student body are continuing their studies, in colleges, universities and different other social jobs training programs. Vacation time for them was wonderful as well, they got into many summer activities, like summer camps, volunteering in hospitals and nurseries, but some went home to help their parents or the families gather in the summer and the fall farming harvest.

For those who stayed over the summer time, here we had a variety of outreaches and activities.

Students were involved in street ministry work, feeding and evangelism, we offer errands work for poor families or single mothers, to care for their kids and let them take a day off, and garden work, like harvesting the corn. This past summer we had a large number of new applicants. We only have room for half.

Not all the time is easy, like for this man's story that in spite of all our doubts ended happily.

We focused a lot of time and special attention for Laurentiu Sirca who came from the state orphanage with a light mental disability, he should have graduated a year ago, but we gave him longer time as he hardly integrated socially and professionally. We worked a lot with him to keep a job, as he repeatedly dropped one by one. But at last he matured and has a job he's holding on to. He ended up saved in Christ as a lost lamb ends up in the hands of the shepherd.

And the last thing needed for him is an apartment, he lives with two other graduates who have graduated successfully from the program, so his training continues. time on his studies, so he can fulfill his life dream and passion.

This summer we encouraged and helped him to work with other more experienced architects in the city, to practice his learning and also get some income. He needs the money for next years expences.

He just finished a house project for which he made the blue print, started building it himself, and by now is finished. All the while he got a little advise here and there from the experienced friends he made before.

But in the process he was also assisted by other of Life Center students who were also involved into construction work, and

Pastor Milo Novacovici:

Our Prevention and Rescue Center operates in Oltenia, the most poor area of Romania. Many of our Life Center Timisoara kids come by the way of the PRC, kids who are needing immediate rescue and life saving.

Crina is a girl that come from a very poor family. Her parents have no jobs and her father has a life threatening health problems. Their home is without electricity and water. Crina is a smart girl but at times the poverty overwhelms her. This year she enrolled in High School but the expenses were too much for her.

Our desire is to help her, if not she might be forced to abandon her further schooling. This could lead to her become a victim at the hands of traffickers who are roaming the area.

Painful but real needs. This is what we confront day by day. The need is overwhelming for us.

Each one of us must get involved, from Romania or America, within our family bond of love, prayers and support.

Pastor Milo, and others can't do it alone, John can't do it alone, and you can't do it alone, and Life Outreach International, James Robison can't do it alone, we have to stay together as the children of Christ, and only then we encounter miracles of rescuing, saving lives for eternity. Let,s help her together to follow her dream for a better life! Each life of these little lambs are important.

That is one of the good reasons the Lord asked me to invest in church planting, and leadership training.

These new churches and pastors even at the beginning may start very poor, but they become life rescuers and a real blessing to their villages and towns. If they begin simply to touch people with the love of Jesus, and there is someone who really cares for them, this is sufficient that one be rescued out of the evil hands and saved by our good Lord.

Then they will increase their commonwealth blessing until the whole town gets changed and prospers.
